June Friday 10-1904 these day begins with
fresh westerly winds and clear weather
bailing start cutting at 7.30 a.m. at noon
got true all hands get dinners at
1 p.m. start work on the head bell the
case and cut up guano at the work
set the watches at 6.30 p.m. so ends

June Saturday 11-1904 these day begins with
fresh northerly winds and squally
weather one sail in sight pump out
water and stored oil down later
part clear up bailing so ends
Lat 32.12 Long 49.18

June Sunday 12-1904 these day begins with
fresh westerly winds and clear
got true bailing at 7 a.m. stored
oil and pump out water got true
stored down at 5.30 p.m. later part
the same so ends Lat 32.30 Long 49.23

June Monday 13-1904 these day begins with
fresh gale from southwesterly and cloudy
under short sail latter part the
same so ends Lat 32.32 Long 49.26

June Tuesday 14-1904 these day begins with
fresh gale from SW. later part
raining squalls lay under tower top
so ends

June Wednesday 15-1904 these day begins with
calm and heavy small cloudy at 7.30
a.m. two of the crew start row L.D.
scores and W. burgland L.D. scores
came to the capt report capt call
Walter and ask him if he do not
know that he did not want any fight
on board and he Walter told the
capt that L.D. scores told a liar
on him so he Walter was going to
fight L.D. scores and capt order
them to scrobe on the decks with
boards so the are at it. middle part
light westerly winds and rain at sun
set short down sail so ends

June Thursday 16-1904 these day begins with
light northeasterly winds and cloudy
weather running steer W. one sail
in sight later part steer W. S.W.
at 2.30 p.m. raised school of whales
damp down three boats get fast come
a long side at 5.50 p.m. short down
sail set the watches so ends
Lat 32.12 Long 50.11

June Friday 17-1904 these day begins with
fresh S.W. winds and squally start cutting
at 5.30 a.m. got true at 7.30 one sail
in sight schooner bailing start the
works at noon latter part the same
so ends
