

July Friday 29-1904 these day begins with calm and clear boiling and stowed oil down set up spades got true boiling at 6.30 p.m. later part the same so ends Lat 32:34

July Saturday 30-1904 these day begins with light air from east stowed oil down steer W. NW. got true stowed down at 11 p.m. all hands at work wash off decks later part the same so ends Lat 32:28 Long 53:01

July Sunday 31-1904 these day begins with light easterly winds and clear weather saw black fish and porpoise later part calm steer W. NW. the whole sail out so ends Lat 32:43 Long 54:02

Aug Monday 1-1904 these day begins with calm and clear weather later part light easterly winds steer W. NW. had a brace out for a cask of oil that leach found him lost a barrel two barrels broke out port one barrel so ends Lat 32:54 Long 54:38

Aug Tuesday 2-1904 these day begins with light air from east steer W. by N. later part southerly the whole sail out so ends Lat 32:56 Long 55:22

Aug Wednesday 3-1904 these day begins with light southwesterly winds and cloudy the whole sail out steer by the wind later part the same so ends Lat 33:18 Long 56:51

Aug Thursday 4-1904 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and clear weather steer by the wind heading N. NW the whole sail out at sun set took in the light sails later part the same so ends Lat 34:33 Long 57:45

Aug Friday 5-1904 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and squally weather under short sail later part the same so ends

Aug Saturday 6-1904 these day begins with fresh NW winds and squally weather at sun set short down sail heavy rain and moderate some so ends Lat 34:18 Long 58:21

Aug Sunday 7-1904 these day begins with fresh westerly gale and squally weather later part moderate some and clear made sail at 8 p.m. steer by the wind heading W. by S. 40 ends Lat 33:56 Long 58:17

Aug Monday 8-1904 these day begins with calm and heavy swell one sail in sight later part light air from east repair fore sail and spandee boards Lat 33:38 Long 58:50
