

Aug Tuesday 9-1904 these day begins with light easterly winds and clear running steer W. N.W. the whole sail out later part the same so ends

Aug Wednesday 10-1904 these day begins with light easterly winds and clear steer W. later part the same so ends
Lat 34:01 Long 60:36

Aug Thursday 11-1904 these day begins with light air from east steer W. by N. later part the same so ends
Lat 33:41 Long 61:27

Aug Friday 12-1904 these day begins with light westerly winds and clear one sail one steamer in sight later part fresh and squally heading S.W. by W. the whole sail out, broke out water and beef so ends Lat 34:20 Long 62:09

Aug Saturday 13-1904 these day begins with fresh westerly winds thick weather steer by the wind heading S.W. later part calm so ends Lat 33:47 Long 63:10

Aug Sunday 14-1904 these day begins with calm and squally weather at 9 a.m. heavy rain later part clear up light W. S.W. winds by night fresh up the whole sail out steer by the wind heading N.W. so ends
Lat 33:30 Long 62:55

Aug Monday 15-1904 these day begins with heavy S.W. gale and heavy squalls lay under lower main top sail and staysails later part hall to the westward and moderate some at 7.30 p.m. set fore top sail and fore sail so ends

Aug Tuesday 16-1904 these day begins with light westerly winds and cloudy steer by the wind heading N. N.W. the whole sail out later part the same at sun set raised school of whales so ends Lat 34:14 Long 64:17-20

Aug Wednesday 17-1904 these day begins with fresh S.W. winds and squally lay under lower top sails and fore sail heading south so bursting down the achers so ends Lat 35:46 N.

Aug Thursday 18-1904 these day begins with fresh westerly winds and squally lay under short sail at noon wind hall to N.W. and cloudy made sail heading S.W. later part the same so ends
Lat 35:30 Long 65:38

Aug Friday 19-1904 these day begins with light N.E. winds and thick weather steer W. repair the mezen staysail later part the same so ends
Lat 35:16 Long 66:28
