Aug Tuesday 23-1904 these day begins with calm and cloudy weather missing the black fish blober ~~out~~ at noon start with rain and thunder later part fresh NE. and cloudy at sun set short down sail steer W. by S. so ends

Aug Wednesday 24-1904 these day begins with fresh gale from NE. steer W. SW. saw two steamers are whaling bar wordro did not spread her later part moderate same and clear so ends

Aug Thursday 25-1904 these day begins with calm and clear weather lots of steamers pass by later part light air from SW. steer N. so ends
Sat 37:40 Tong 71:55

Aug Friday 26-1904 these day begins with fresh gale from NW. later part hall to the northern wash the paint and slowed the black fish oil down under short sail so ends
Sat 39:34 Tong 71:59

Aug Saturday 27-1904 these day begins with light northerly winds and clear lots of steamers tow sail in sight later part calm got the stinks out of the boats cutting stay in saw tow barrels drop a boat got them patrol oil so ends
Sat 39:57 Tong 72:34

Aug Sunday 28-1904 these day begins with calm and cloudy lots of sail and steamers later part light air from west steer N. NE. the whale sail out so ends
Sat 39:58 Tong 72:18

Aug Monday 29-1904 these day begins with light SW. winds and thick weather made contact at 9 a.m. steer E. by N. later part light air from the northern lug a breast of black Island steer E. NE. so ends
