This 24 Hours attends with pleasant breeze & fine
Weather Middle part the same Latter part fine
One watch on liberty so goes this 24 Hours

Remarks on Board Thursday August 16th 1838
This twenty four Hours commences with fine weather
Wind from East the Dutch free trader sail for Java
Middle part very light air Latter part a sea breeze
Came in so ends this twenty four Hours

Remarks on Board Friday August 17th
This twenty four Hours commences with a strong Sea breeze
Middle part a calm Latter part a Sea breeze the
Convoy of London from the straits 15 months with 350 bbls

Remarks on Board Saturday August 18th
This day attends with a Sea breeze Middle part calm
Latter part a Sea breeze come in strong One watch
on liberty so ends this 24 Hours In Copang Bay

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 21th
This twenty four Hours commences with moderate
breeze from the Eastward one watch on liberty Middle
Part light air Latter part strong Land breeze
So goes this twenty four Hours In Timore Bay

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 22th
This twenty four Hours commences with a strong
Land breeze Middle part light breeze at
Daylight call all hands commence heaving up the
Anchor at 6 AM took the Anchor and steamed out of the
Bay at 9 AM spoke Herat Capt. Richardson with 300
Barrel Bann in to Copang employes stowing the
Anchor so ends Lat 7.49 South 3 miles from Line

Remarks on Board Thursday August 23th
This day light breeze from the Westward Steaming NE
Along the Land Middle part light air from E. S. E.
steering by the wind the st. Easty at daylight Pt. Goulabator
Rock bearing E. S. E. about 5 leagues distance strong breeze
at 3 PM tack to the South saw a ship in shore at
Meridian calm so ends Lat 9.12 Long by Chron 123.45

Remarks on Board Friday August 24th
This twenty four Hours attends with moderate breeze
from from N. W. steering E. S. E. pass about 2 miles
from Goulabator at 6 P. M. fell to a calm Middle
Part at 10 PM got a fine Land breeze steamed down
the land with in 2 miles at Meridian of best of Batogay
Harbor saw a sail of in the straits made the Lat 8.54
so ends
