Remarks on Board Wednesday October 31st

This day commences with a calm at 10 P.M. get a light breeze from S.W. standing to the S.E. Middle part the same Latter part a calm so ends Lat 119.07 Long 119.07 E

Remarks on Board Thursday November 1st

This day attends with a calm Middle part get a light breeze from S.E. standing to the E.S.E. Latter part at 7 P.M. tack ship headed up South employed repairing the fore topmast so ends Lat 11.10 Long by Chron 119.11

Remarks on Board Friday December 2nd

This light breeze from E.S.E. steering South Middle part continued of S.W. at 10 o'clock tack ship Latter at 7 P.M. tack ship to the South employed repairing sails Lat 11.34 Long 118.35

Remarks on Board Saturday November 13th

First part of this day light breeze from S.E. steering S.W. at 6 P.M. tack ship headed up East Middle part the same Latter part a ship in sight standing to the N. Englishman at 8 A.M. tack ship headed up South Lat 11.32 Long 118.44

Remarks on Board Sunday November 14th

Commences with a fine breeze from S.E. standing to the S. at 7 P.M. tack ship Middle part the same Latter part all sail out standing to the South saw high fish at sea this day any times Lat 11.52 Longitude by Chron 119.08

Remarks on Board Monday November 15th 1838

Attends with fine weather wind from S.E. standing to the S.E. at 4 P.M. tack ship headed E. by S. Middle part the same Latter part light airs so ends Lat 11.32 Long 120.7

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 16th

Commences with a strong S.E. breeze steering E. at 6 P.M. took in topgallantsails and courses Middle part at 11 tack to the S. Latter part standing to E.S.E. saw blackfish so ends any signs Lat 11.29 Long by Chron 120.38

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 17th

Attends with a fine breeze from S.E. standing to the E.S.E. Middle part shorten sail at daylight New Island in sight to the S.E. at 10 A.M. saw bearing N.E. 15 miles Banjoan bearing N. hauled up and steered W.N.W. at Myridrum New Island bearing West 2 Leagues Lat 11.50 South Long by Chronometry 121.07 East Found the ship to be 80 miles to the westward of Chron

Ship Young Phoenix of New Island 1838

Remarks on Board Thursday November 5th 1838

Commences with fine moonsoon steering to W.N.W. at 2 P.M. haul on the wind to the S.W. at sunset shorten sail for the night Middle part light breeze Latter part a fine breeze at 5 A.M. tack ship to the S.E. 20 miles Lat 11.17 Long 120.58

Remarks on Board Friday November 9th 1838

Commences with fine weather as usual standing to the S.E. at 4 P.M. saw New Island bearing E. by S. at 8 P.M. tack to the South Middle part at 11 P.M. tack ship to the E.S.E. at daylight New Island bearing N.E. by N. steered for it at 8 A.M. sent 2 boats ashore for turtle at 11 A.M. returned saw great many in air and the track where they crawled up night and saw goats so ends Lat 10.54

Remarks on Board Saturday November 11th 1838

weather the same at 2 P.M. 3 boats went ashore for goats and turtle at 3 P.M. one returned with 2 goats the other 2 stop all night for turtles Middle part stood of till 10 P.M. took in wind in that to the South headed up E.S.E. at daylight change in bearing S.W. and saw bearing with steered West by N for New Island at 7 A.M. saw it Middle bearing N.W. by W 3 miles so ends Ingeat New Island Lat 10.50 South Long by Chron 121.32

Remarks on Board Sunday November 11th 1838

Commences with fine weather a fresh breeze from S.E. at 1 P.M. the boats returned from Twitlin and never got one shot 5 goats and caught one small one alive all sail out stand to the West at 8 P.M. Sandlewood in sight of the sea shorten sail tack ship to the S.E. Middle part at 12 veered ship to West Latter part stand in side Sandlewood at 11 P.M. tack of head of S.E. by S. so ends Lat 10.35 Long 121.03 E

Remarks on Board Monday November 12th

Fine weather standing to the S.E. wind from S.W. at sunset shorten sail Middle part very light airs at daylight New Island in sight bearing N.E. 5 Leagues veered to the West so ends with a fine breeze Lat 11.49 Long 121.17

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 13th

A fine breeze from S.E. standing to Westward at 2 P.M. Sandlewood in sight of the beam at 4 P.M. saw a sail in shore Middle all sail put Latter part the same so ends this day Lat 11.02 South Long 116.54 East
