

Ship Young Phoenix 1838.

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 14th 1838.

Fine weather wind from South steering to N. at 3 P.M. tack to the E.S.E. Middle part the same Latter part no alteration. So ends this day. Longitude 117° 51' Long by Chron 120° 30'

Remarks on Board Thursday November 15th

Light breeze from South steering to the E.S.E. Middle part at 3 P.M. tack ship to the N.W. Latter part at 8 A.M. tack ship to the South so ends. Lat 11° 29' Long 120° 12' E.

Remarks on Board Friday November 16th 1838

Attends with light southerly breeze and fine weather steering to the S.E. at 3 P.M. tack ship to the N.W. Middle part light Latter part steering to the South employed mending sails so ends dry times. Lat 11° 47' Long 119° 52' E.

Remarks on Board Saturday November 17th 1838

Moderate & heavy winds with passing clouds standing to the S.E. at 3 P.M. tack ship to the N.W. Middle part a cabin Latter part a light air from S.W. standing to the S.E. saw nothing so ends employed mending sails. Lat 12° 10' Long 119° 36' E.

Remarks on Board Sunday November 18th

Moderate breeze from S.W. standing to the S.E. at 3 P.M. tack ship to the West Middle part light air Latter part steering to the S.E. so ends dry times no night. Lat 12° 37' Long 119° 15' E.

Remarks on Board Monday November 19th 1838

Drish breeze from the S.W. standing to the S.E. at 4 P.M. saw a sail to windward at 6 P.M. tack ship to the N.W. Middle part light breeze from S.W. Latter part quick breeze standing to the S.E. employed mending sails saw fin back saw a sail to the Leeward so ends. Lat 13° 16' Long 118° 25' E.

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 20th 1838

Moderate breeze from S.W. standing to the N.W. at 6 P.M. shorten sail for the night Middle part the same Latter at 6 A.M. saw a large Whale and a school of cows and calves yawning to the S.E. lowered the boats for the large whale but he saw the whale they could not get near him at 11 took up the boats. Lat 14° 42' Long 118° 56'.

Wednesday the 21st of November fine weather at 1 lowered the boats at 3 P.M. struck a small Whale at 4 took him to the at 5 P.M. finish cutting at sunset shorten sail for the night Middle at 9 tack ship to the S.E. Latter part tack ship to the N.W. saw nothing so ends boiling. Lat 12° 52' Long 118° 45' East

Ship Young Phoenix of New Bedford 1838

Remarks on Board Thursday November 22nd 1838

Fine with moderate breeze from S.W. standing to the N.W. at 3 P.M. tack ship to the S.E. at 5 P.M. saw a school of Whales steered for them at 4 p.m. & lowered the boats but it was too late it was dark before they got up with them Middle with the main top sail to the mast headed to East Latter standing to the N.W. at 10 A.M. tack ship so ends this day employed repairing sails. Lat 12° 52' Long 118° 56' E.

On Board Friday November 23rd 1838 fine weather

standing to the N.W. at 8 P.M. shorten sail Middle part standing to the West Latter part at 7 A.M. veered ship to S.E. at Meridian steering to the N.W. so ends day. Longitude 13° 05' Long by Chron 118° 52' E.

Remarks on Board Saturday November 24th

Fine weather steering S.W. with a quick breeze from S.W. at 6 P.M. shorten sail for night and veered ship to the E.S.E. Middle part the same Latter part standing to the N.W. saw jumper so ends. Lat 12° 42' Long 117° 56' East

Remarks on Board Sunday November 25th

quick breeze from South steering W by N at 4 P.M. veered ship to the West Middle part under short sail Latter part steering East so ends. Lat 12° 51' Long by Chron 118° 57' E.

Remarks on Board Monday November 26th 1838

Moderate breeze from S.E. steering to the East at 5 P.M. shorten sail for the night Middle part headed up at 8 A.M. Latter standing to the N.W. so ends. Lat 12° 45' Long 118° 59'

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 27th 1838

Moderate breeze from S.W. standing to the N.W. at 6 P.M. shorten sail for the night Middle part standing to the S.E. at daylight call all hands and commence sending down the fore topmast to put on a new head at 10 A.M. got it down so ends dry times. Lat 12° 41' Long 118° 37'

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 28th

Light breeze and fine weather laying under the main top sail headed to the S.E. Middle part the same Latter finish the topmast saw a large flock of small birds so ends this day Drish breeze. Lat 12° 47' South Longitude by Chron 118° 36' E.
