

Ship Young Phoenix in the Straits of Bally
Monday January 14th Light breeze from westward
Middle part weather the same at daylight call
all hands and got the ship under way run down to the
river and anchored in 46 fathoms of water with young
Sham point bearing S. E. 5 miles distance sent the boat
of wooding so ends this day. Ends

Tuesday January 15th Light breeze from all point of
of the compass with heavy thunder and lightning
Over the Land Middle part the same Latter part
the same employed wooding so ends

Wednesday January 16th Light breeze from all points
of the compass with light squalls of rain and a bundance
of thunder and lightning Middle part the same Latter
part strong from S. W. employed wooding and stowing

Wednesday January 17th Fresh breeze with overcast weather from
S. W. Mitchell heavy squalls of rain Latter part light breeze the Pacific
towed out employed wooding so ends

Friday January 18th Light baffling breeze from all point of
the compass Middle part calm Latter the same so
ends got of the last weather

Saturday January 19th Squally with light shower Middle part
calm Latter part employed stowing away the water one boat
went to Bangui for the pilot to take the ship to port
Uttrich at seven finished so ends

Sunday 20th Employed cleaning ship a little and Latter
part the on shore washing their clothes in water
Variable so ends

Monday 21st First part of the day squally with rain at 8.
A. M. the boat return with the pilot at 11 got underway
with a light breeze from the S. E. so ends

Tuesday 22nd First part of the day rainy at 5 P. M. came
in 48 fathoms of water Port Uttrich bearing per compass
West 2 or 3 miles Latter part fine weather employed
unbending the S. G. sails and courses so ends

Wednesday 23rd Commences with strong N. E. and rain
at 6 P. M. wind variable at 7 P. M. 3 boats crews on liberty
Latter part of the day clear weather with strong
breezes from the Northward so ends

Thursday 24th These twenty four hours commenced with strong
N. E. winds at 4 squally with heavy rain attended with
winds light and variable Latter part clear weather
so ends this 24 hours

Friday 25th Light variable winds cloudy at 4 strong
squall from the N. E. with much heavy rain Latter
part of the day light airs and variable clear weather

Saturday 26th All these twenty four hours a light northerly
winds variable at 6 P. M. all of the liberty men returned

Sunday 27th Commences with light winds from N. E.
cloudy at 4 squally with rain at midnight cloudy
Latter part of the day weather variable all hands
on board so ends this day

Monday 28th At 11 these twenty four hours a light
Northerly wind Rainy 3 boats crews on liberty and this ends

Tuesday 29th First part and Middle of the day heavy rain
with lightning and thunder light Northerly winds
Latter part weather variable so goes this day

Wednesday 30th All of this day light variable winds
inclining to Calm 3 boats crews on liberty and this ends

Thursday 31st Commences with light northerly winds
with heavy showers of rain Latter part light winds and
calm so ends

Friday 1st Throughout this day light winds and variable
weather one boat employed hoisting of Hogs fowls from the

Saturday 2nd First part of the day a fresh breeze from N. E.
cloudy at 6 midnight much the same at 7 P. M. all of
the liberty men returned Latter part of the day employed
hauling the S. G. sails Courses jibbs and stowing the boats
anchors and other things Ends

Sunday 3rd Commences with fresh breezes from
Northward clear weather at 4 P. M. have up the anchor
got underway at 6 P. M. Young Sham point bearing
S. W. 5 Leagues Middle part light variable winds at 9

A. M. passed S. E. point of Janga made the S. E. point 11 P. M.
by Chronometer. Left at 8.00 A. M.
