 Sunday 10th Commences with strong wind from S.E.
 backing on and after looking for the boat and whale
 Middle part the same Latter part moderate
 driving on and after so ends Lat 24.10 Long 109.47
 Monday 11th Commences with a fresh breeze from
 S.E. driving on and the other saw nothing Middle part
 standing to the East with all sail out Latter part
 shot to the West fine weather so ends Lat 24.11 Long 110.00
 Tuesday 12th Commences with strong winds again took in
 topgallant sails Middle part the same Latter part
 blowing strong so ends Lat 24.11 Long 109.49 East
 Wednesday 13th Commences with strong winds as
 as usual at 5 P.M. spoke a French ship 8 months out
 Middle part blowing heavy double reefed Latter
 set single reefed topsails and mainsail so ends this day
 saw nothing else times Lat 24.40 Long by Chron 108.50
 Thursday 14th Commences with strong southerly winds and
 overcast weather standing to the S.E. at 4 P.M. took
 to the East Middle the same Latter part more
 moderate wind from S.E. steering S.W. so ends
 this day Lat 24.45 Long 108.40 E.
 Friday 15th Commences with fine weather standing
 to the S.E. at 4 P.M. back ship to the S.E. Middle
 and Latter parts the same saw nothing Lat 24.30 Long 108.35
 Saturday 16th Commences with strong southerly winds employed
 repairing sails Middle and Latter parts the same
 saw nothing so ends this day Lat 24.33 Long by Chron 109.27
 Sunday 17th Commences with quite fair weather standing
 to the S.W. at 4 P.M. took to the East Middle and Latter
 parts the same strong breeze as usual Lat 24.50 Long 110.00
 Monday 18th Commences with strong southerly wind standing
 to the East Middle part more moderate Latter breeze
 on with a thick heavy haze so ends Lat 25.05 Long 110.00
 Tuesday 19th Commences with strong S.E. winds standing to
 S.W. at 4 P.M. saw a sail to windward steering to the North
 at sunset steering for us double reefed and let the main topsail
 come to the mast at 8 P.M. spoke the Japan of Southwick 8 months
 out with 430 bbls of sperm Latter blowing strong Lat 26.25 Long 109.00

Ship Young Prince W. Coast New Holland
 Wednesday 20th Commences with strong breezes from S.E. steering
 to the S.W. at 4 spoke the Japan again and got some soap
 and corn Middle part and Latter parts strong gales under
 double reefed topsails so ends Lat 27.25 Long 107.55 E.
 Thursday 21th Commences heavy gales from S.E. steering
 S.W. at 5 P.M. veered ship to the S.E. Middle and
 Latter more moderate standing to the S.E. so ends
 this day Lat 27.25 Long 108.45 East
 Friday 22th Commences with strong breezes from S.E.
 standing to the S.E. Middle part and Latter parts
 no alteration blowing heavy Lat 27.24 Long 110.00
 Saturday 23th Commences with strong gales from
 S.E. steering to the S.W. under double reefed topsails
 at 4 P.M. veered ship Middle and Latter fine weather
 saw nothing so ends Lat 26.45 Long 109.45 E.
 Sunday 24th Commences with fine weather standing to
 W. S.W. Middle part the same Latter standing to
 the East saw nothing so ends Lat 26.44 Long 109.32
 Monday 25th Commences with strong breezes again
 standing to the East Middle double reefed the topsails
 blowing on at 12 o'clock took in the main topsail Latter
 part blowing heavy took in fore topsail and color reefed
 the main veered ship to the S.W. so ends Lat 26.25 Long 110.00
 Tuesday 26th Commences with a strong gale from S.E. under
 color reefed main topsail and fore sail Middle part
 split the fore sail Latter part blowing heavy so ends
 this day Lat 26.44 Long 110.12 E.
 Wednesday 27th Blowing heavy under color reefed main
 topsail Middle and Latter parts the blowing heavy
 with drizzly weather so ends Lat 26.45 Long 110.00
 Thursday 28th Commences with a heavy gale from
 S.E. with much drizzly weather Middle and Latter
 parts the same so ends Lat 26.40 Long 109.50
 Friday 29th Commences with a heavy gale under color
 reefed main topsail the barometer at 29 inches Middle
 and Latter part moderate a little at 9 A.M. veered ship
 a heavy swell running so gave this 24 hours
 Lat 26.30 Long by Chron 108.25 E.
