

Remarks on Board Ship Young Phoenix  
 Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> Commences with a fresh breeze from S.W. steering  
 to the S.E. at 1 P.M. set fore topsail and bent a fore and set it  
 Middle part moderate. Latter good weather with the wind  
 from S.W. standing to the S.E. a very heavy rowling swell  
 from the S.E. so was with all sail at Lat 29.09 Long 109.26 E  
 Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> Commences with light breezes from S.W. with light  
 signals of rain Middle part double reefed Latter set whole  
 topsail and main topgallant sail steered S.E. light squalls of rain  
 so gave this day Lat 28.11 S Long by Chron 110.26 East  
 Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> Commences with fresh breezes from West  
 steering S.E. Middle part under main topsail Latter part  
 set whole topsails weather hazy headed up South saw nothing  
 so ends Lat 27.12 S Long by Chron 111.4 East  
 Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> Commences with moderate breezes and good weather  
 steering South Middle took ship to the S.W. Latter  
 fine all sail set saw nothing Lat 27.15 Long by Chron 110.47 East  
 Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> Commences with fine weather wind from S.W.  
 all sail set at 2 P.M. took ship to the S.E. Middle part  
 steering to the S.E. Latter part strong breezes from South  
 standing to the S.W. so gave this day Lat 27.32 Long 111.46 E  
 Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> Attends with strong breezes from Standing  
 to the S.W. Middle part under double topsails Latter  
 set single reefed topsails and main topgallant sail headed up  
 S.W. at 11 A.M. saw a breach steered for it at 11 saw the  
 whales spout lowered the boats so ends Lat 26.00 Long 110.25  
 Friday 6<sup>th</sup> Commences strong breezes but fine weather  
 at 1 P.M. fasten and got 4 small whales and a large  
 one at 4 P.M. got them all to the ship set the watch  
 a shoal of cows and calves with 2 large whales with them  
 going to the S.E. Middle part the same at 11  
 pop 3 A.M. took on at 10 got the large whale in got dinner  
 so ends Lat 25.45 Long by Chron 110.28 E  
 Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> Commences with fine weather at 5 P.M. got  
 all in but the large whale head got supper and set  
 watch Middle strong squalls from S.E. with rain  
 employed cutting and clearing the decks at day light  
 broke on and hauled in the head set the work again  
 so ends Lat 25.36 Long by Chron 110.38 East

Remarks on Board Ship Young Phoenix  
 Sunday April 7<sup>th</sup> Attends with strong winds from S.E.  
 with clear weather employed clearing away the heads  
 and jaws and traversing the work at 4 P.M. veered  
 ship to the west south west Middle strong Latter part  
 the same employed boiling so ends Lat 24.00 Long 109.30 E  
 Monday 8<sup>th</sup> Commences with winds from S.E. standing  
 to the S.E. at 4 P.M. veered ship to the S.W. Middle the  
 same Latter fine saw nothing wind from S.E. so gave  
 this day Lat 23.3 S Long by Chron 109.58 E  
 Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> Fine weather boiling away and mending boats  
 so Middle part and Latter weather the same made  
 sail standing to the East saw nothing Lat 23.53 Long 108.50  
 Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> Fine weather wind from S.E. steering  
 to the East at 2 P.M. finish boiling and wash of  
 Middle part at 10 P.M. whales spouting close to the  
 ship at daylight made sail standing to the S.W. at  
 11 pop 10 A.M. saw whales at 11 lowered the boats whale  
 going to the south so ends Lat 23.35 Long 109.14 East  
 Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> Commences with fine weather struck  
 3 large whales and got one kill 2 at 8 P.M. took  
 him to the ship Middle the same at day light took  
 on weather overcast with light signals of rain at 11 A.M.  
 got all in and eased set up and commence boiling so  
 this day weather squally Lat 23.30 Long 109.09  
 Friday 12<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong from S.E. with  
 squalls of rain employed clearing the jaw and drive  
 ing the oil and lashing so Middle blowing strongest  
 the fore sail and commence boiling Latter part the  
 same a heavy sea running Lat 23.5 Long by Chron 109.00  
 Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> Commences blowing heavy gale from S.E.  
 with clear weather Middle moderate some so we  
 could creep full pots Latter strong squalls emptying  
 cooping boiling so ends Lat 23.00 Long Do  
 Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> Commences strong gale employed cooping  
 so Middle more moderate at 11 P.M. finish boiling  
 blowing heavy at 1 A.M. finish lashing the tooth in the  
 fore sail Latter part more moderate standing down  
 in the after hole so ends Lat 22.03 Long 107.44 East
