

Ship Young Phoenix in Straits of Dallas
Friday, 31st of May 1839 first part attends with
a strong moonsoon found the Marianna of London
6 months out with 140 bbls the Hercules of New Bedford 2 years
out with 100 bbls of sperm Middle light airs Latter
part strong trade employed stowing down the
oil so ends

Saturday June 1st commences with a fresh
moonsoon employed stowing stowing down the oil
Middle part light calm Latter a sea breeze again
finish the oil so ends

Sunday 2nd All hands employed cleaning ship at 5
P.M. got out of the Bark Marianna of London and clear
again without doing any material damage to our ship.
Carried away the mariannas davits on the Leeward side
mizen cross trees and some of their rigging stove one boat
brake spar pole &c. &c. Drove up the anchor and shifted
our berth Latter part one watch on liberty

Monday 3rd employed making preparation for caulking
the ship top sides refitting the Bobstays &c so ends

Tuesday 4th Strong sea and Land breezes at 7 A.M.
commences caulking the ship outside Latter strong
Northeasterly wind with clear weather one watch on
liberty so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday 5th commences with strong Northeasterly wind
Northeasterly winds days and land breezes nights employed
caulking one watch on liberty and four hands cutting
timber for the Marianna davits so ends

Thursday 6th Employed caulking one watch liberty
strong Northeasterly winds days and light land breezes
nights so ends

Friday 7th commences with strong Northeasterly
winds in the day employed caulking Middle part calm
Latter breeze up N.E. again one watch on liberty so ends

Saturday 8th commences with strong N.E. winds finish caulking
the topwork Middle part a Land breeze Latter part
employed scraping ship so goes this day

Sunday 9th commences with light sea breeze Middle a Land
breeze Latter got Fair Ob. Bally road by of several sites
Long 116° 36' 30" East Lat 24° 42' South

In Bally town Roads in 10 fathoms. 10.
Monday 10th Fresh Land and Sea breezes employed
refitting Bobstays martingale &c so ends

Tuesday 11th All of this day light Land and sea breezes
Employed on sundays jobs about the rigging so ends
Wednesday 12th Sent a shore 50 Bbls of coals to be filled
at 4 A.M. took on Board 50 bbls of water and stowed
it below it in pass 9 sent 35 bbls more at 8 A.M. took
of 44 Baskets of potatoes at 10 55 Baskets of potatoes

Thursday 13th Commences with fresh Land and Sea
breezes I boats crew on shore filling water at 7 A.M.
took on Board 40 bbls of water at noon hoisted the anchor
and got underway took on Board at Bally potatoes
squash pumpkins Bananas and 100 bbls of water

Friday 14th A light sea breeze heating up for Peju
at 4 P.M. came to in Peju Harbor in 7 fathoms
of water the rivers mouth bearing per compass S. 82
E. 1/2 of a mile of shore Latter part one watch on
liberty so ends

Saturday 15th A light Sea breeze at 6 A.M. commences
caulking the heads 10 hands on shore cutting wood
and so ends this 24 hours

Sunday 16th first part employed caulking the
Latter part light Sea breezes men on liberty
Left of Peju Harbor 8.00 A.M. Long by Chron. and
Lunars Obs - 116° 29' 45" E.

Monday 17th all of this day strong Land and sea
breezes 8 hands on shore working caulking the heads
and painting ship

Tuesday 18th first part of this day strong sea breezes
at midnight a calm at 5 A.M. 5 hands a working
the rest employed painting ship and caulking heads

Wednesday 19th commences with a strong Sea breeze
Employed painting a party on shore working
Latter getting of wood stowing it away &c

Thursday 20th commences with a strong sea breeze
employed painting and cutting and stowing wood
Latter part blacking heads the boats getting of wood
a light Land breeze so goes
