 Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> Commences with a very light air from S  
 steering N Middle part a calm Latter a light air from  
 East so ends Lat 16.48 South Long by Chron 115.08 E  
 Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> first part a calm Middle part a fine  
 breeze from S. E. steered E. S. E. Latter part the  
 same so ends Lat 16.14 S Long by Chron 116.20  
 Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> Commences with a fine breeze from S. E.  
 with fine weather steering E. S. E. with all sail set  
 Middle the same Latter part wind from E. S. E. headed  
 North so ends Lat 15.00 S Long by Chron 117.28 E  
 Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> first part a fine breeze from E. S. E.  
 headed up North Middle part a strong moonsoon took  
 in topgallantsails Latter part the same so goes this  
 twenty four hours Lat 13.05 S Long by Chron 117.47 E  
 Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> Attends with a strong moonsoon steering  
 by the wind to the E. S. E. at 8 P.M. took to the South  
 Middle the same Latter took to the S. day a surf bottom  
 so ends Lat 13.26 S Long by Chron 117.55 E  
 Monday 26<sup>th</sup> commences with moderate breezes steering  
 to the S. E. Middle the same Latter at 7 o'clock took  
 ship to the South so ends Lat 12.44 S Long by Chron 117.57  
 Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> commences with moderate fresh S. E. steering  
 S. S. W. at 5 P.M. took ship to the S. E. Middle  
 the same Latter employed setting up the rigging so  
 ends this day Lat 12.18 S Long by Chron 118.30 East  
 Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> first part fine weather moderate breeze  
 from E. S. E. steering by the wind to the S. E. Middle the  
 same Latter part very smooth so ends Lat 10.55 S Lat 119.25  
 Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> commences with a fresh moonsoon at 2 pass  
 Meridian saw Saglewood island ahead at 5 P.M. took  
 tack of shore Middle part working up a long sandalwood  
 shore Latter headed to the weather of the island so goes  
 this day fine weather Lat 10.33 S Long by Chron 119.44 E  
 Friday 30<sup>th</sup> attends with moderate breezes from S. E. steering  
 by the wind to the S. E. at sunset East point of Sandalwood  
 bearing S. E. by S per compass headed up East Middle part  
 the same Latter no alteration at Meridian saw bearing  
 South so ends Lat 10.11 S Long by Chron 121.30 E  
 found the Chron 2 minutes or 30 miles to port

 Remarks on Board Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> 1831  
 Commences with strong wind from S. E. steering  
 East with all sail out Middle part the same at 3 o'clock  
 saw the Island of Semas at 4 took the Land breeze beating  
 in the ofing at Meridian got the Sea breeze so end this  
 day sand Island bearing S. E. per compass  
 Sunday (September) 2<sup>nd</sup> Commences with a strong Sea  
 breeze standing in for the town at 2 P.M. come to  
 in 19 fathoms of water Middle part calm Latter  
 part employed cooping and beketen cask fore  
 weather so ends  
 Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> first part strong sea breeze Middle  
 light air Latter employed stowing of the fore hole  
 so ends this day  
 Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> At 10 of these twenty four hours strong  
 land breezes clear weather at 11 o'clock took on board  
 40 Bbls of water Latter part employed stowing Water  
 Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> first part of the day strong land breeze  
 employed stowing empty Casks At midnight winds light  
 at 7 o'clock took on board 120 Bbls of water Latter part  
 strong land breeze  
 Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> At 10 of this day strong winds two hours  
 crew on sandy island a wooding wood scarce  
 Friday 7<sup>th</sup> strong sea breeze clear weather at 4  
 P.M. took on board 2 boats loads of wood At 8 o'clock  
 a boat sent to Semas for pigs & pumpkins  
 Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh S. E. winds at 6  
 boat returned from Semas with a few goats at 10 o'clock  
 took on board bags of corn 14 Bbls of water and sand  
 Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> fresh sea breeze clear weather at 4 P.M.  
 have 55 fathoms of chain at 6 took on board a boat  
 load of pumpkins and onions at 7 o'clock got underway  
 at 10 o'clock spoke the Barkley of New Bedford so ends  
 Monday 10<sup>th</sup> Standing to the S. E. a light sea breeze in  
 company with the Ship Barclay at daylight steering in  
 for Nyluit Lat 9.24 South
