Friday October the 18th Commenced with fine weather wind
from S.E. steering to the S.E. Middle part under short sail
Latter tack to the S.W. saw a sail to the windward so ends this day

Lat 12.54 S Long by Chron 113.18 East

Saturday 19th Attends with strong breezes from S.E. standing
to the S.W. at 3 P.M. took ship & Middle under 5 top sails fore
sail Latter blowing strong set the main top galant sail jib and
Spanker stood to the S.W. so ends Lat 12.45 S Long Chron 113.19 E

Sunday 20th Commenced with strong winds from S.E. standing
to the S.W. at 8 P.M. double reefed, wore ship from night & under
part the same Latter steering to the W. the whole top sail and
courses saw great many birds Lat 13.00 S Long by Chron 113.17 E

Monday 21st First part strong breezes from S.E. to the S.W.
Middle part double reefed headed up on the other tack East
Latter all sail out at 8 A.M. tack ship to the S.W. so ends

Tuesday 22nd First part Lat 12.57 S Long 113.19 East
Moderate breezes from S.E. steering S.W. Middle took
in top galant sail Latter all sail out steering to the S.E. & S.
saw nothing so ends day times Lat 13.26 S Long by Chron 112.57 E

Wednesday 23rd Commenced with light breezes from S.E. steering
to the S.E. Middle took in light sails Latter part & calms
so ends Lat 13.4 S Long by Chron 113.21 East

Thursday 24th Commenced with a light air from S.W. steering
to the S.E. Middle part the same Latter no alteration very
light air so goes Lat 13.25 S Long by Chron 113.37 E

Friday 25th Attends with light air from South steering S.E.
Middle and Latter parts the same light air and fine weather
so ends Lat 13.25 South Long by Chron 113.13 East

Saturday 26th Commenced with fine weather light air from
South steering S.E. Middle part under 5 top sail and fore sail
Latter part all sail out headed up South Lat 13.40 S Long 113.42 E

Sunday 27th Light-buffing air from S.W. steering to the S.E.
with all sail Middle part buffing Latter part the same
steering S.E. so ends Lat 14.18 S Long 116.24 East

Monday 28th Commenced with a fine breeze from N.W. steering
South Middle and Latter parts much the same
saw porpoises dry times so ends Lat 15.18 S Long 116.11 East

Cruising for Spinn Whales S.D. 1839.
Remarks on Board Thursday October 29th 1839.

First part a fine breeze from N.W. steering S. with all sail
out Middle and Latter parts the same sail nothing so goes
this day dry times Lat 16.25 S Long by Chron 117.59 E
Wednesday 30th Commenced with light breezes from S.W.
steering S.E. at 6 P.M. tack ship to the West Middle
the same Latter a strong breeze steered S.W. so ends
this day Lat 15.51 S Long 117.11 East

Thursday 31st Commenced with strong breezes from South
steering S.W. Middle by two Latter part steered S.W.
pass a ship steering East so ends Lat 14.3 S Long 116.35 E

Friday November 1st Commenced with moderate breezes
and fine weather steering S.W. Middle under short sail
headed up West Latter made all sail steered Westworthly
so ends this day Lat 14.10 S Long by Chron 115.31 E

Saturday 2nd Commenced with moderate breezes from
S.W. steering W. Middle part shorten sail for
the night at daylight made all sail steered S.W. at 8 A.M.
saw a large whale lifted to wind at 9 tack to S.E. & S.

acquiring S.E. at 10 pass & lowered the boats so ends
in pursuit of the whale Lat 13.48 S Long 114.40 E

Sunday 3rd at 10 pass meridian struck at 11 pass 2 P.M.
took him to the ship got dinner and hook on at 4.3
saw a mother large whale a mile from the ship loud

all the boats at 4 struck at 5 took him to the anchor
cutting got one jaw in shorten for the night Middle
fine at daylight hook on at meridian got the body of one
and the others jaw so ends Lat 13.49 S Long by Chron 114.50 East

Monday 4th Fine at sunset got all but one head at
works blowing Middle cutting up and boiling Latter the
same so ends Lat 14.05 S Long by Chron 115.13 E

Tuesday 5th Commenced with fine at 2 P.M. hook on the
other and took it in Middle part & driving the
the try works Latter part weather fine so ends
Lat 14.14 S Long 115.20 E

Wednesday 6th First part fine Middle the same
Latter near ship & made sail at 9 A.M. saw whale at 10
lowered the boats whale going to the S.W. so goes this day
Lat 14.20 S Long
