Homebound Passage From N. H. Island

Thursday June 15 1848

Fresh breezes from the S.E. Steaming N.W. & W.
at 2 P.M. saw three ships at 1.3 saw one of
them take a whale along side the other 2 ships
in chase of the whale at 9 P.M. spoke the ship
George Capt Clarke 6 months out 20 bbls 50
in company with the Hibernia Capt Shorman
62050 600 W. latter part in company with
George at 11 A.M. spoke the William Badger
Capt Perkins with 85050 100.50 humpback
Lat 23° 20' S Long 109° 25' E

Friday June 16 1848

Fresh breezes in company with the G and
W. W. Badger middle part steering N.W. & W.
latter part the same
Lat 23° 00' S Long 107° 51' E

Saturday June 17 1848

Fresh breezes steering W. W. W. middle part steering
S.W. latter part steering N.
Lat 22° 10' S Long 106° 20' E

Sunday June 18 1848

Fresh breezes from S.E. steering N. middle
part heading S.W. latter part steering N.W. & W.
Lat 21° 40' S Long 105° 30' E

Monday June 19 1848

Strong breezes from the S.E. Steaming N.W. & W.
middle and latter part the same
Lat 21° 00' S Long 104° 15' E
