Those 24 hours begins with light breeze  
from the S.E. and rain; all sail set  
middle and latter - strong from the N.E.  
all sail set so ends

Lat 6° 16' S Long 160° 57' W

Monday April 22 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with strong breezes  
from the S.W. steering N.W. by N all sail  
set middle and latter part the same so ends  
Lat 3° 50' S Long 162° 29' W

Tuesday April 23 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with ~~light~~ strong  
breezes from the S.W. steering N.W. by N  
all sail set middle and latter part the same  
Lat 1° 34' S Long 164° 28' W

Wednesday April 24 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with strong breezes  
from the N.E. steering N.W. all sail set  
middle and latter part the same so ends  
Lat 1° 08' N Long 165° 15' W

Thursday April 25 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with strong trades  
from the N.E. steering N.W. by N all sail  
set middle and latter part the same so  
ends Lat 3° 07' S Long 167° 32' W

Friday April 26 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with ~~light~~ strong  
trades N.E. steering all sail set middle  
and latter part the same so ends  
Lat 5° 07' S Long

Saturday April 27 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with strong  
breezes from the S.E. at 2 P.M.  
took in the mainsail and jib and  
mizen topsail steering N.W. under  
double reef fore and mizen top sails  
and for sail middle and latter part  
moderate at 6 A.M. made all sail so ends.

Sunday April 28 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with strong trades  
from the N.E. steering N.W. all sail set  
middle and latter part the same so ends  
Lat 8° 45' S Long 171° 23' W

Monday April 29 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with strong trades  
N.E. steering N.W. all sail set middle  
and latter part the same so ends  
Lat 11° 17' S Long 174° 19' W

Tuesday April 30 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with strong trades  
steering N.W. by W all sail set middle  
and latter part the same so ends  
Lat 13° 11' S Long 176° 28' W

Wednesday May 1 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with strong steering  
N.W. by W all sail set middle and  
latter part the same so ends  
Lat 15° 47' N Long

Thursday May 2 1851  
Those 24 hours begins with moderate trades  
steering N.W. by W all sail set middle and latter  
part the same Lat 18° 23' N Long
