 Those 24 hours begins with moderate
 trades steering N W by W all sail set
 middle and latter part the same so ends
 Lat 24.18 N Long 172.23 E

Monday May 6 1851
 Those 24 hours begins with light breezes
 from the SE steering N W by W all sail
 set middle and latter part calm all hands
 employed in bracing
 Lat N Long E

Tuesday May 7 1851
 Those 24 hours begins with light breezes
 and calms SE steering N W by W all sail set
 Lat S Long E

Wednesday May 8 1851
 Those 24 hours begins with light breezes
 from the SE steering N W by W all sail
 set middle and latter part the same
 Lat 28.57 N Long 171.00 E

Thursday May 9 1851
 Those 24 hours begins with strong breezes
 from the W steering N N W under
 topsails and courses middle and latter part the
 same Lat N Long E

Friday May 10 1851
 Those 24 hours begins with strong breezes
 from the N N W heading N W by N
 all sail set middle and latter part the
 same Lat 31.34 N Long 172.30 E

Saturday May 11 1851
 Those 24 hours begins with strong breezes
 from the S S W steering N N W
 all sail set middle and latter part the
 topgalant sails in at 8 am double reef the
 topsails and at 11 took in the fore and
 mizen topsails and close reef the main
 so ends Lat 33.24 N Long E

Sunday May 12 1851
 Those 24 hours begins with strong gales
 from the N N W heading N E under
 close reef main topsail and fore and
 middle and latter part more moderate make all
 sale so ends Lat 34.10 Long E

Monday May 13 1851
 Those 24 hours begins with light breezes
 from the N E heading N N W all sail
 set the watch employed in sending down the
 topgalant masts so ends
 Lat 35.23 N Long E
