Sunday August 24 1851  
strong breezes employed in boiling and scraping  
down Lat 68° 15' N Long 171° 01' NW


Monday August 25 1851  
strong breezes from the N W boiling middle  
and latter part the same so ends  
Lat 68° 32' N Long 171° 10' NW

Tuesday August 26 1851  
strong breezes from the N W at 4 AM  
finished boiling middle and latter part  
the same ~~latter part~~ showing down 200 to 300 lbs  
Lat N Long NW

Wednesday August 27 1851  
strong breezes from the N W middle  
and latter part the same so ends  
Lat 68° 45' N Long NW

Thursday August 28 1851  
begins with strong breezes from the  
N W at 6 PM have two under close  
sheet mainsail and fore course plenty whales  
in sight middle and latter part more  
moderate so ends

Friday August 29 1851  
begins with strong breezes very foggy at 4  
lowered the boats got nothing middle and latter  
~~moderate~~ moderate at 8 AM lowered the boats got a whale  
took him along side  so ends

Saturday August 30 1851  
at 7 PM commenced cutting at 5 finished cutting  
and commenced boiling middle and latter part  
the same Lat N Long NW

Sunday September 31 1851  
all hands employed in boiling and scraping down  
middle and latter part fine weather so ends  
Lat N Long NW

Monday September 1 1851  
commences with fine weather at 1 PM saw  
whales lowered the boats got one and took him  
along side and commenced cutting at 8 AM  
finished cutting and commenced boiling so ends  
 Lat 68° 40' N Long 171° 20' NW

Tuesday September 2 1851  
all hands employed in boiling middle and latter  
part the same Lat N Long NW

Wednesday September 3 1851  
all hands employed in boiling middle and  
latter part the same so ends  
Lat N Long NW

Thursday September 4 1851  
all hands employed in boiling middle  
and latter part the same  
Lat N Long NW
