begins with strong breezes and rain  
all hands employed in stowing down middle and  
latter part the same so ends  
Lat N Long W

Friday September 17 1851  
begins with strong gales stowing down middle  
and latter part moderate so ends  
Lat 67° 40' N Long 170° 10' W

Saturday September 20 1851  
begins with strong breezes and pleasant weather  
at 12 PM commenced boiling middle and latter  
the same at 7 AM spoke the ship Washington  
of New Bedford 7 whales  
Lat N Long W

Sunday September 21 1851  
begins with strong breezes and rainy  
middle and latter part more moderate so ends  
Lat N Long W

Monday September 22 1851  
begins with strong breezes from the S.W.  
at daylight commenced stowing down sounds  
Lat N Long W

Tuesday September 23 1851  
begins with strong breezes from the S.W.  
employed in stowing down middle and latter part  
the same  
Lat 67° 50' N Long 170° 15' W

Wednesday September 24 1851  
begins with light breezes from the N.N.W.  
steering S.E. at 7 PM finished stowing down 200  
lbs middle and latter part the same  
Lat N Long W

Thursday September 25 1851  
begins with light breezes from the N.E.  
steering S.E. by S all sail set at 9 AM  
commenced taking in sail at 7 under a close  
reeft maintop sail and force at 11 it moderate  
and we made sail so ends  
Lat N Long W

Friday September 26 1851  
begins with light breezes from the S.E. at 3 PM  
made the land 35 miles N.W. of barrow straits  
stuck a ship to the N.E. middle and latter  
strong strong gales from the N.W. and a thick  
snow storm 2 ships in sight  
Lat N Long W

Saturday September 27 1851  
begins with strong breezes from the N.W.  
at 3 PM made the mouth of the straits veered  
ship and headed in under close reefed topsails  
and corfsail and spanker 1 ship in sight at 7 PM  
abrest of the cape with all sail set so ends  
Lat 65° 30' N Long W

Sunday September 28 1851  
begins with strong breezes from the E and rainy  
steering S all sail set middle and latter part  
the same a sail night Lat N Long W

Monday September 29 1851  
begins with light breezes from the W steering  
S by W all sail set middle and latter part the  
same  
Lat N Long W

Tuesday September 30 1851  
begins with light breezes from the W steering  
S by W middle and latter part the same  
Lat 59° 42' N Long 170° 51' W
