steering S S W all sail set middle and latter
part the same Lat 58.17 N Long 177.22 W

Thursday October 2 1851
begins with light breezes from the N E
steering S W by S all sail set middle and
latter part the same
Lat 57.43 N Long 179.39 W

Friday October 3 1851
begins with light breezes from the W S W
steering S all sail set middle strong breezes latter
part moderate Lat 57.28 N Long W

Saturday October 4 1851
begins with light breezes from the S heading
W all sail set middle and latter part strong
gales from the S S W at 12 AM bore too
under close reef on topsail and fore
Lat N Long W

Sunday October 5 1851
begins with strong gales from the S W
heading N N W at 4 PM veered ship to the
S E middle and latter part the same so ends
Lat 57.11 N Long W

Monday October 6 1851
begins with heavy gales from the W S W
heading S by W under a close reef on topsail
middle part the same latter part moderate
Lat 56.20 N Long W

Tuesday October 7 1851
begins with light breezes from the N at 3 PM
made all sail steering S W by S middle and
latter strong breezes Lat 55 N Long

Wednesday October 8 1851
begins with strong breezes from the N E
steering S W all sail set middle and
latter part light Lat 53.28 N Long E

Thursday October 9 1851
begins with light breezes from the N W
steering S W by S all sail set ~~at~~ at the
island roughly in sight middle and latter part
the same Lat N Long E

Friday October 10 1851
begins with light breezes from the N E
middle and latter part strong so ends
Lat 50.30 N Long 170.29 E

Saturday October 11 1851
begins with strong breezes from the S E
heading S double reef topsails at 8 PM shortened
sail at 12 AM under close reef on topsail and fore
course wind from the E steering S by E at 5 lost the
starboard ~~boat~~ boat left too and took in the fore course
Lat N Long E

Sunday October 12 1851
begins with strong gales from the N N E
heading E under close reef on topsail middle and
latter part moderate at 10 PM heaved S by E and
made sail latter part all sail set
Lat 45.28 N Long E

Monday October 13 1851
begins with strong breezes from the N E
steering S by E all sail set middle and latter
strong gales at 5 AM ~~lost the~~ boat at 8
AM took in the fore and main topsails
