heading S by E all sail set middle and latter
part the same Lat 19.36 N Long

Wednesday October 29 1851
begins with light NE trades steering
S by W all sail set middle and latter part
the same Lat 18.51 N Long 170.27

Thursday October 30 1851
begins with light trades steering S by W
all sail set a sail in sight middle and
latter part the same Lat N Long

Friday October 31 1851
begins with light trades steering S by W
middle and latter part the same
Lat 15.37 N Long

Saturday November 1 1851
begins with strong trades steering S by W
all sail set middle and latter part
Lat 13.36 N Long

Sunday November 2 1851
begins with strong trades steering S by W
all sail set at sunset shortened sail at
daylight made all sail
Lat 11.14 N Long 164.15

Monday November 3 1851
begins with moderate trades all sail set
middle and latter part the same
Lat 9.51 N Long

Tuesday November 4 1851
begins with light breezes from the E
steering S by W all sail middle and latter
part the same Lat 8.42 N Long 162.20

Wednesday November 5 1851
begins with light breezes from the S by E steering
S by W all sail set middle and latter part the
same Lat 7.44 N Long 160.27

Thursday November 6 1851
begins with light breezes from the E by E
steering S by W by S all sail set middle
and latter part the same
Lat 6.58 N Long 160.13

Friday November 7 1851
begins with light breezes from the NE steering
S by W all sail set middle and latter part the
same at 7 AM saw the island of San Juan
Lat 6.57 N Long 159.52

Saturday November 8 1851
begins with light breezes from the NE
steering W all at 5 PM cast anchor at
Shenston weather harbor so ends
