begins light breezes Stearing ESE all sail set  
Lat 00.19 S Long E

Tuesday December 16 1851  
begins with light breezes and calm Stearing  
ESE Middle and latter part the same  
Lat 00.38 S Long E

Wednesday December 17 1851  
begins with light breezes from the NNE  
steering ESE all sail set at 3 PM saw  
pleasant island at sunset took in sail and  
tacked ship to the westward at 3 am  
tacked in shore at 8 the natives came of with  
fruits at 11 stood of shore so ends  
Lat S Long E

Thursday December 18 1851  
begins with light breezes from the NNE  
steering W all sail set at sunset took  
in sail Middle and latter part the same at  
daylight made sail so ends  
Lat S Long E

Friday December 19 1851  
begins with light breezes at 1 PM saw  
whales lowered the boats and chest got  
nothing at 5 come on board Middle and  
latter part rainier so ends  
Lat S Long E

Saturday December 20 1851  
begins with fine weather & sail in  
sight at sunset shortened sail at daylight  
made all sail at 11 saw whales lowered  
the boats got one whale at 10 took him  
along side Lat S Long E

Sunday December 21 1851  
begins with fine weather at 2 PM  
commenced cutting at 5 finished cutting  
& spoke the ship meteoric of ~~the new bed~~  
18 months out 1200 whale at 10 ends  
Lat N Long E

Monday December 22 1851  
begins with fine weather at 1 PM  
commenced boiling Middle and latter part  
the same Lat 00.24 N Long E

Tuesday December 23 1851  
begins with fine weather at 1 PM spoke  
the bangall new London 18 ME 2000  
and the snowbird of Nantucket 20 ME  
out 600 SE Middle and latter part the same  
Lat N Long E

Wednesday December 24 1851  
begins with light breezes in company with  
the Medecomb of New Bedford Middle and latter  
part the same Lat 00.20 N Long E

Thursday December 25 1851  
begins with light breezes the land in  
sight at 2 PM the natives came of with fruits  
asail in site Middle and latter part the  
same Lat N Long E

Friday December 26 1851  
begins with light breezes and pleasant  
all sail set Middle and latter part the  
same Lat N Long E

Saturday December 27 1851  
begins with strong breezes and pleasant the  
land and a sail in sight at sunset took in sail
