begins with light breezes and squales
at sunset took in sail middle and latter
part the same at daylight made sail
a sail in sight at 9 AM spoke the oneco
so ends Lat N Long E

Thursday January 1 1852
begins with light breezes and pleasant
the land in sight at 6 PM spoke
the ship ~~rose~~ of sidney Capt Jones
middle and latter part the same

Friday January 2 1852
begins with light breezes and pleasant
3 ships in company at sunset took of shore
middle and latter part the same

Saturday January 3 1852
begins with light breezes and squales
3 sail in sight at sunset took in sail
middle and latter part the same at daylight
made sail 1 sail in sight so ends

Sunday January 4 1852
begins with light breezes 1 sail in
sight at sunset took in sight sail
middle and latter part the same at
daylight made sail so ends

Monday January 5 1852
begins with light breezes from the
N E N at sunset took in sail middle
and latter part strong N E trades
Lat 3 55 N Long E

Tuesday January 6 1852
begins with strong trades steering N W
middle reef topsails middle and
latter part the same at daylight
