

August	Ship Josephine 1843
Wed day 16 th	begins with strong breezes and unpleasant weather at 2 P.M. set the fore top mast stand sail at 5 A.M. wind hauls to the south at 8 A.M. tacked and stood to the N. S. W. but a back standing the same way no obs to day
Th day 17 th	begins with strong gales from south better wind hauls to the S. E. Course S. W. by S. at 10 A.M. past a brig standing to North no obs to day
Fri day 18 th	Commences with fine breezes from S. E. and unpleasant weather saw a brig standing to the north Lat 32-00 Long 44-03
Sat day 19 th	begins with light breezes and rainy weather at 8 A.M. saw a brig standing to the S. W. and at 10 A.M. saw a large break ahead but being heavy we see it no more but think it was a large sperm whale Libemir of Sooty by a bore in the grind
Sun day 20 th	Commences with strong by S gales from S. E. Course S. W. at 4 P.M. made sail weather more moderate no obs this day

August	Ship Josephine from S. 13
Mon day 21 st	begins with light breezes and thick fog at 2 P.M. tacked ship and stood to the south visible part strong gales from S. W. at 4 P.M. took in all sail except the Spencers gale in Creasing Lat 36-31 Long 46-43
Tue day 22 nd	Commences with strong gales from S. S. W. Saw a brig standing to the S. E. Lat 37-04 Long 44-27
Wed day 23 rd	begins with strong gales from S. W. at 10 A.M. sent down the fore top gallant mast and sent in the flying jib from the gale in Creasing Lat 39-20 Long 46-32
Th day 24 th	at 10 A.M. sent down the main top gallant mast and took in the lower boat wind now from S. E. and gale in Creasing Cork Slick of Sooty Lat 39-24
Fri day 25 th	through the day strong gales from S. W. Ship staying to under short sail Lat 39-41
Sat day 26 th	Commences with heavy gales at 3 P.M. wore ship and stood to S. W. at 4 P.M. wore ship to the south no obs this day
