begins with fine weather

sail latter part unpleasant
no obs to day

Fri Day 30th

begins with strong breezes
from S.W. and unpleasant
weather latter part wind
from S.W. John Rice fell from
the foot of the spanker beam
on deck and was hurt some

pleasant weather and fine
breezes from N.E. Course S.W.
latter part wind blowing
heavy Lat by 10 P.M. 44-26
