Sun Day 1st th

Ship Left
at 11 AM got under way
and put George Taylor on
and all his things for mending
on board and went to sea
with 23 Capt. Mason kept
the same moving for Payta
all hands well

Mon Day 6th

begins with pleasant weather
all hands employed in
getting ready for whales
Lat 2° 39' Long 82° 07'

Tue Day 7th

Commences with pleasant
breezes and fine weather
all hands employed in ship
Lat 00° 31' Long 83° 32'

Wed Day 8th

begins with pleasant
weather and fine breezes
from S W course west
Lat 00° 07' S Long 84° 07'

Th Day 9th

through the day light airs
and pleasant weather
all hands employed in ship
Lat 00° 08'

Fri Day 10th

begins with light airs
and pleasant weather
Lat 1° 28' S Long 85° 11'

Sat Day 11th

begins with light breezes
day all night under Charles
Island Lat 7° 21'

Sun Day 12th

through the day light airs and
pleasant weather but no whale
Charles Island in sight

Ship Left of 1st 13

Mon Day 13th

begins with light airs and
pleasant weather saw black
fish but did not lower for them
Lat 1° 10' S Long 92° 00'

Tue Day 14th

through the day strong breezes and
pleasant weather nothing seen to day
Lat 00° 25' S Long 94° 43'

Wed Day 15th

begins with fine weather and
pleasant breezes in lent
the chain and stowed the
anchors Lat 00° 06' S

Th Day 16th

begins with pleasant weather
and fine breezes the bow
boat in repairing at 11 P.M.
I went on deck and found
the boat stores a heap on deck
against my orders Lat 00° 24' S
Long 95° 24' by
Lunar alt 95° 22'

Fri Day 17th

light airs and pleasant
weather but no whales
Painted the deck and
maist boats Lat 00° 14' S

Sat Day 18th

begins with light breezes
and pleasant weather at
1 P.M. saw whales and
lowered 3 boats the Staker
struck and all got
lost but the barbed
boat cut her line and
got making the Staker
killed but the ship
keeper lost and at 4 P.M.
to ship Lat 00° 00' S
Long 102° 22'
