Tuesday 2nd first part light breezes
and pleasant weather all
hands employed repairing
the main sail at 7 A.M.
saw a ship to be near
showing a blue white and
black signal saw pin
back Lat 08° S

Wednesday 3rd first part strong breezes
and no whales and but
little hopes of seeing
any at 3 P.M. saw a sail
standing to the S.S.W.
Lat 23 miles South

Thursday 4th Begins with strong
travels and fine weather
spoke the ship Zoro Capt
Chase 27 months out you
bills Lat 0° S

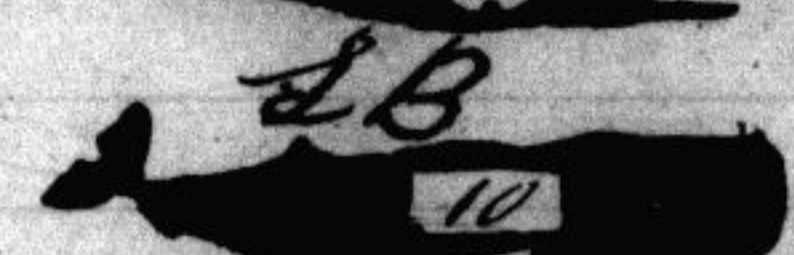
Friday 5th through the day nothing
remarkable Lat 4° 43' S

January on the Line
begins with strong
breezes at 9 A.M. saw
whales a balling
1 point on the weather
Boat 8 miles off at
10 A.M. bore at 11 A.M.
the Staked boat got fast
and at 12 o'clock
took him along side
No obs to day

Sunday 7th



at 2 saw more whales
and bore and
all got fast the water
bore line parted
and lost the whale
the boat steered off
bore boat mist
a large whale with
a gold chain so much
for having fore boat
steered Lat 1° 30' S

Monday 8th

at 3 P.M. finish cutting
in and commence bailing
the skiff still remains
sick and no better
Lat 1° 37' S Long 130° 21'

Tuesday 9th

through the day light
air and pleasant weather
finished bailing 48 hours
12 A.M. Lat 2° 29' N

Wednesday 10th

through the day light air
and pleasant weather bore
the oil and cut some
fish Lat 3° 37' S
Long 126° 48' West
