Thurs day 2th Throng the day bright
air and rainy the
main top sail down
to repair nothing seen
to day

Fri day 1th Begins with bright air
and cloudy weather
latter part the same
onkyhee in sight but
no whales

Sat day 2th Throng the day calm
lent the main top sail
off the S E point of
onkyhee

Sunday 3th Begins with Calms and
very hot the ship
An abander in sight
so end this day

Monday 4th Throng the day calm
and warm saw a bloom
of pinbalks ship off South
Point

Tue day 5th first part of these 24 hours
sent down the main
top sail yard and sent
up a new one setting
seen

Wed day 6th bright air and hot
sent down the fore top
sail yard and sent
sent the main one
in it place Lat 19 11 8

March 1844

Th day 7th begins with Calms and
very hot latter part
a bright air from S E
saw 7 ships under the
lee of the land standing
to the S E sent down
the main top gallant
sail to mend Lat 19 11

Fri day 8th Throng the day bright
air and pleasant weather
sent down the main top
gallant sail to repair
ship off the Kapaemahu
Bay and several ships
in sight Lat 19 14 S

Sat day 9th first part of these 24 hours
bright air and very warm
lent the main top gallant
sail and mended down the
fore top mast rigging and
saw several other fairs
of ships Lat 19 44 S

Sunday 10th first part bright air and
fine weather - trying to get
to Abouhee shore ship
Caledonia Capt J. J. J. J.
7 months 300 lbs w Pib
Bound to S W Coast

Monday 11th at 1 P M Come to anchor
at Abouhee with 200 lbs
on board. Etn ship still
sick
