whales and banded 3
boats and at 6 P.M. the
Stahed boat got

at 9 A.M. saw whales
and banded 4 boats and
the Lahad got past
but the men came
out the waist got
past and were from

Latter part squally weather
Saw a ship Lat 30° 35' 8'

Wed Day 7th th

Begins with stormy bellies
and unpleasant weather at 9
P.M. spoke the Concord Gary
of Nantucket 31 months out
1200 sperm oil Lat 31° 25'

Thurs Day 8th th

first part of these 24 hours
stormy bellies from South
Latter part more pleasant
at 6 A.M. Commence stowing
down in the main hatch
Lat 31° 04'

Fri Day 9th th

Begins with light air
and pleasant weather at
4 P.M. finished stowing
down Latter part in play
in cleaning ship Lat 31° 04'

Sat Day 10th th

Through the day light air
and pleasant weather all
hands employed in ship
Duty Lat 30° 31' Long 149° 54'

Sat Day 11th th

first part of these 24 hours
fine bellies and pleasant
weather part in play in
cleaning Latter part
Saw a whale stowing
to South Lat 29° 49'
Long 149° 54' East
