Monday 12th Through the Day Strong
beers from ESE at 4
P.M. talked to the North
Lat by obs 28° 31' S

Tuesday 13th Begins with strong
beers and pleasant weather
at 4 P.M. saw a sail to
the Eastward Lat 29° 26'

Wednesday 14th first part pleasant weather
saw a sail to the East
at 4 P.M. commenced strong
saw a sail to the Eastward
of purpose Lat 29° 00'

Thursday 15th Begins with pleasant
weather and fine beers
from East at 4 P.M.
Spoke the Ship Hera
of Nantucket 33 months
out with 440 lbs. had
lost a man by blowing
the day before
Lat 30° 08' S Long 140° 08' E

Friday 16th first part of these 24 hours
light airs from SE ship
steering to the S.W. at 4 P.M.
talked to the East saw a
sail to North had 80 whales
10 months out to day with
440 lbs. and have lost 200
more by bad management
Lat 30° 31' S

Saturday 17th Begins with strong
beers from North
at 4 P.M. spoke the
Ship Indian of London
11 months out 300 Lat
31° 31' Long 131° 34'

Sunday 18th

August 1844 Japan

Commenced with strong
beers from SE ship
steering to the East a sail
in sight to the S.W. at 4
P.M. talked to the West and
10 P.M. talked to the East
saw nothing of whales and
but little hopes of getting
any more this season at
Lat 29° 24' Long 179° 11' East

Monday 19th

first part of these 24 hours
light airs and pleasant weather
Steward. Sailed of Duty better
part saw a sail to the S.W.
Lat 30° 09' Long 172° 48' East

Tuesday 20th

Begins with strong beers
from SE at 2 P.M. talked
ship to the ESE better part
saw a sail to the Eastward
Steward remains sick of
Duty Lat 30° 27' S

Wednesday 21st

Begins with strong beers
and pleasant weather better
part slightly and no whales
Lat 30° 11' S

Thursday 22nd

first part of these 24 hours
lightly weather better part
light beers and rainy saw
a sail to the East Lat 31° 04'

Friday 23rd

Begins with light beers
from SE at 6 P.M. spoke
the Ship Damon Capt
Patten 24 months out with
600 sperm all well
Lat 31° 00'
