1st day 18th

first part of the gear hauled
moderate breezes from South
at 2 P.M. saw a sail to the
westward Course S.S.E.
later part pleasant weather
Lat 30 45 North

2nd day 18th

Begins with squally weather
saw fin backs and lost
some fish to salt on
bent the spanker to repair
Lat 29 45 Long 176 30 E

3rd day 19th

through the day squally
weather went a sail to the
westward Lat 29 40 Long 176 00

4th day 20th

Begins with pleasant breezes
and fine weather bent the
spanker John mission
to return Coopers duty
hooker hickey of duty sick
Lat 30 45

5th day 21st

first part strong breezes
and cloudy weather all
hands employed in the rig
of ship Lat 30 00 N
Long 176 47 East

6th day 22nd

first part light air
and pleasant weather in the
fore top sail and bent
up one better part
pleasant at 6 o'clock saw
Sperm Whales and lowered
a float and after a 10 hours
hard tag come on board without
sailing Lat 30 22 S Long
177 45 E
