Sat Day 11th

Begins with Strong breezes and unpleasant weather at 10 AM better part calm and rainy with a heavy swell on land part but no whales at obs to day

Sun Day 12th

first part calm and rainy weather ship heading to the west wind from S^W & S^W part calm and rainy Lat 12° South Long 178° 16 West

Mon Day 13th

these 24 hours begins with calm and a heavy sea rising better part calm and pleasant weather all hands employed repairing the mizen top sail Lat 12 miles S Long 178° 46 W

Tues Day 14th

Begins with calm weather and warm all hands employed in repairing mizen top sail at 6 PM bent it better pleasant breezes from S^W ship heading to N^W & N^W unbent the main spencers and riped in up Lat 14 miles S Long 179° 36 West

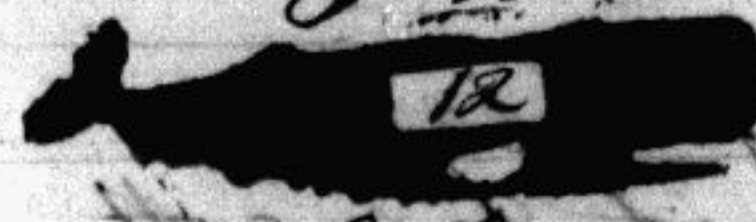
Wed Day 15th

Begins with pleasant weather and moderate breezes from S^W ship steering to N^W by better part unbent the fore sail to repair Lat 17° 38 S Long 179° 14 East

Th Day 16th

first part strong breezes and pleasant weather at 1 1/2 PM saw sperm whales and lowered the stated boat got fast and killed 3 and at 6 PM took them to ship's care and

and lost one of them through neglect of the 2d officer not putting the plank chain on by 1 PM - I have lost one hand's full of air this day by not having the men in the truly heart sick of the voyage at 1 PM saw more whales and at 2 finished with one and engaged without success at 8 PM obs to day

Begins with pleasant weather and moderate breezes employed better part calm Lat 11° 06 S Long 177° 11 East

through the day light air and pleasant weather unbent the fore top gallant sail and spanker Lat 22 miles South Long 175° 56 East

first part calm saw many porpoises better part light air and pleasant weather Lat 17 S Long 178° 19 East

Begins with light air and pleasant weather 1 match employed repairing the spanker better part for all hands at work Lat 19 miles S Long 177° 14 East

first part calm and very hot warm latter light breezes and pleasant weather shortened the spanker down saw plenty of porpoises Lat 19 miles S Long 177° 37 E
