Feb 1845 at R. Mills of

Sat Day 1th

first part of these 24 hours
light air and pleasant weather
Ship lying between
the 2 islands. We Calmed and
a strong current setting the
Ship to the S^E all hands
employed repairing main
top sail at 6 PM got up
the laborer chain and bent
it Ship. S^E at 7 1/2 PM saw
a light on Clashes Island
batter part moderate breezes
from S^E Ship heading to W
the 2 Wans in sight Lat
21° 04' Long by Chron 174° 37' E
by Gun 174° 33' E

we Day 5th

Begins with Squally weather
wind from W S W Ship heading to
the S^E W at 5 PM made hall
J^o and baring North at 4 PM
Spoke Ship Galen of Warren
Bowers Master 26 months out with
400 of Speers and 1200 of whale oil
bound to S^E Coast batter part
Squally Ship lying between
the 2 islands S^E obs to Day

Sat Day 6th

first part Squally weather at
6 PM Spoke Ship Galen batters
middle and batter part heavy
Squally from west Lat 28° 8'
Long 173° 14' East

Sun Day 2th

Begins with light breezes
and pleasant weather calm
in light batter part Calm
Saw black fish and bowered
but got nothing Lat 1° 38' S
Long 173° 52' East

Mo Day 7th

Begins with strong breezes and
unpleasant weather at 1 PM made
revolve. ~~Spoke~~ a Sprints of bee
low at sunset it baring S^E E
Dist 4 miles and at 7 AM saw
Spenderville baring S W and at 8
hepts of S^E by E for Simpsons
Island and at 11 AM saw Ship
Emerald of New Bedford among
whales bowered all and at 12 o'clock
I returned on board and the mate
and second mate went on
board of Ship E and take dinner
and did not return until I had
run within hail of her

Mon Day 3th

first part light breezes and
pleasant weather Ship Steering
W S W wind from S^E E
batter part Calm Lat 1° 38' S
Long 173° 15' East

Sat Day 8th

Begins with strong breezes
and unpleasant weather in
Ship E in Company batter
part pleasant weather
Saw Ship Galen of Warren
among whales Lat 28° 8'
Long 174° 28' East

Tu Day 4th

Begins with pleasant
weather all hands employed
repairing main top sail saw
black fish at 11 AM saw
revolve Island baring S^E E
Lat 14 miles South Long 172° 15'
