Long by Chron 174° 29' East
Long by Gun 174° 10' East

Tue May 11th Begins with light breezes
and pleasant weather
at 1 Pm Ship Ship Bern
monrey of London 30 gun
sperm latter part in
company with the same
Ship Lat Long 173° 28'

Wed May 12th Begins with moderate
breezes and pleasant all the
boats of after black fish
and got 1 at 1 Pm returned
on board and found no
table up and said something
about it and nearly the
Hawai played the harp at

others unbecoming words

winds ship heading to
N & W and S by W Lat
32 miles S Long 171° 52' East
