Boats got past and
hills at 11 am took them
to ship L & A also to day

Tuesday 18th Begins with light air
and pleasant weather
Whale in chase of the
whaler and at 2 pm returned
on board and batt in the
Whaler and made sail
Ship Yalen in sight
Lat 11° 8' S Long 172° 00' E

Wednesday 19th first part pleasant
weather & employed
boiling and at 11 pm kinsip
Lat 33° S Long 170° 12' E

Thursday 20th Through the Day light
air and pleasant weather
Ship Yalen in Company
wind from SE Ship heading
NNE Lat 10° 7' S Long 169° 41'

Friday 21st Begins with light breezes
from ESE Ship steering
NNE pleasant weather
employed preparing fore
& 3 sail Lat 11° 48' S
Long 165° 44' E

Feb 1847 Bound to Guam

Saturday 22nd Begins with moderate
breezes and pleasant weather
wind from SE Ship steering
NNE by Compass Ship
Yalen in Company seen
of nothing of date Lat 2° 48'
Long 167° 24' E

Sunday 23rd Through the Day strong
breezes from SE Ship
heading NNE Ship
Yalen in sight Lat 3° 51'
Long 164° 43' East

Monday 24th first part squally with
strong breezes from SE
Ship heading S by NNE
at 8 am made strong
Island & Point of the Labaca
Bore 20 miles distant to
End the Day no obs to Day

Tuesday 25th Begins with fresh breezes from
SE at 3 pm passed strong
Island to the Southward
Spoke Ship Yalen latter squa
ly Ship heading under easy
sail Lat 6° 49' S Long 162° 11'

Wednesday 26th Through the Day strong breezes
and cloudy weather all
hands employed repairing
fore top sail Lat 8° 01' S
Long 157° 12' East

Thursday 27th first part strong trades
and pleasant weather all
hands employed repairing
fore top sail & latter part
much the same Lat 9° 15'
Long 156° 21' East of
Greenwich
