the fore and main top Gallant
mast and yards and sending in
the flying jibb Hoove and
at 3 Pm the jibb stay parted
Commence fitting a new one
the plan of note in sight
Lat 14th 11 S Long 145th 26 East

Sun day 29th Begins with moderate breezes
and pleasant weather all hands
employed in the duties of the
ship better part pleasant
Lat 13th 25 S Long 145th 17 E

Mon day 30th first part of the 24 hours
moderate breezes and pleasant
weather Mr. Porter threatens to
the duty of second mate
better part pleasant with
light breezes at 8 Am went
on shore to ship Amate
and found the 2 men that
Deserted 22 day ago in
prison So Enid the day
