and rainy 8 to obs to day

May 16th

Begins with light airs and
rain 2 sails in sight better
part calm 8 to obs to day

May 17th

through the day calm
and rain 8 to obs to day

May 18th

Begins with strong breeze
and unpleasant weather
better part heavy gales
Ship heading S by E 8 to
obs to day

May 19th

Begins with heavy gales
from ESE Ship heading
S by E at 1 PM take in
the fore sail and main top
sail at 8 AM the fore top
mast stay sail blown away
by the sheet parting all abt
crane of topmast Lat 28.09

through the day light airs
and pleasant weather bent the
mizen top sail 8 to sing of
whales Lat 27.13 S Long 140.00 E

Wednesday
May 21st

through the day light airs and
pleasant sent up the main
top gallant yard and take
on deck 20 bbls of oil
Lat 28.05 S Long 137.25 E

Thursday
May 22nd

first part calm at 2 PM
Spoke ship Emerald of
S. M. middle and better
part foggy Lat 28.05 S

Friday
May 23rd

Begins with light airs and
thick fog Ship heading to SSE
in latter part reaches to SSE
8 to whales Lat 28.33 Long 138.48

Saturday
May 24th

first part pleasant saw
hills 8 to sing of whales
better part heavy gales from
East have the ship to under
fore and main spencers and
at 10 PM the gale abate
8 to obs to day

Sunday
May 25th

Begins with calm and very
heavy swell on better part
pleasant thick fog no whales
Lat 28.13 S Long 139.44 E
