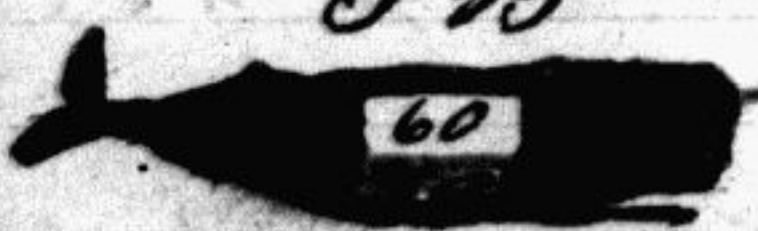
Through the day moderate

 again and lowered 2 boats but
 lost the whales in Squab
 latter part moderate breezes at
 9 AM spoke Barke Lee
 Kiney Master sick 10 months out
 100 at 11 AM sperm whales
 Lat 29° 47' S^W
