July 19th

Begins with light airs and pleasant weather. About in chase of the whales at 4 pm the west boat got fast to a small whale and killed him and took him to ship and cut him in latter part employed boiling 1 ship in sight Lat 29° 34' North

July 20th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather. Employed boiling latter part Calm at 4 pm finished boiling Lat 29° 47'

Monday
July 21st

Begins with light airs and pleasant weather at 4 pm saw sperm whales and land ice without sails latter part Calm Lat 29° 56' North

Tuesday
July 22nd

first part Calm saw many porpoises in sight and 80 whales. latter part employed stowing down ship heading S & Lat 30° 04'

Wednesday
July 23rd

Through the day pleasant weather all hands employed stowing down saw sperm whales Lat 29° 27' N

Thursday
July 24th

Through the day pleasant weather wind from N. E. ship heading to the S. M. employed stowing down Lat 29° 00' N

Friday
July 25th

Through the day employed stowing down weather pleasant wind from N. E. ship heading to the westward Lat 29° 01' N

July 1845 Japan

Saturday
July 26th

Through the day employed stowing down oil wind from N. E. ship heading N. M. at 5 pm saw a sail steering to Southwest Lat 29° 40' N

Sunday
July 27th

Begins with light airs from N. N. E. and pleasant weather at 5 pm saw ship and stand to the South latter part sitting remarkable Lat 29° 19' Long by Lunar obs 162° 06' East

Monday
July 28th

Through the day light breezes from E. S. E. with pleasant weather ship heading N. N. E. Lat 29° 55' N

Tuesday
July 29th

Begins with moderate breezes and pleasant weather at 1 pm spoke the ship General of N. Bedford latter part squally weather wind from E Lat 30° 28' North

Wednesday
July 30th

first part of these 24 hours strong breezes and pleasant weather latter part unpleasant ship heading to N. E. N. E. obs the day

Thursday
July 31st

Through the day strong gales from S. E. and unpleasant weather ship heading E. S. E. Lat 32° 04' N Long 163° 14' East

Friday
August 1st

Through the day strong gales and unpleasant weather wind from S. E. ship heading to the N. E. and S. M. Lat 30° 36' N Long 163° 10' E

Saturday
Aug 2nd

Through the day light strong breezes and unpleasant weather

Sunday
Aug 3rd

3 ships in sight Lat 30° 20' N Through the day strong breezes and unpleasant weather at 5 pm spoke the ship m. S. Lat 29° 54' N
