Sunday Sept 28th	first part moderate breezes from S E ship heading to the S E at 2 pm saw breacher 40 ft 4 points on weather band at 5 1/2 pm lowered but got nothing Latter part pleasant Lat 29° 15' N	Tuesday Oct 7th	first part strong breezes from S E Latter part squally weather at 2 pm saw sperm whales lowered without success S E to day and 10 am the latter part boat got fast to a small whale at 10 am today
Monday Sept 29th	Through the Day Calm and pleasant weather Employed setting up the mizen rigging Lat 29° 44' N Long 172° 49' E	Wednesday Oct 8th	Begins with strong gales at 2 pm took the whale to ship and cut him in Latter employed hauling Lat 30° 25' N Long 175° 45'
Tuesday Sept 30th Wednesday Oct 1st	Still there 24 hours Calm Lat 29° 31' N Long 173° 30' E first part Calm and pleasant Latter part moderate breeze from S W ship heading S E Lat 29° 43' N Long 174° 18' E	Thursday Oct 9th	Through the Day strong gales all hands employed hauling Lat 30° 18' N
