 the body Lat 30° 29' S

 weather at 4 1/2 am finished butting
 the case and to commence butting
 latter part fine weather and
 eyed butting Lat 30° 00' S

 the boat boat got shore like

 Tuesday
 May 19th
 at 3 pm took the whale to
 the ship many sperm whales
 in sight latter part employed
 butting and butting Lat 25° 29' S
 Wednesday

 pleasant weather employed
 butting Lat 25° 54' S
 Thursday
 May 21st
 first part pleasant weather
 latter part employed butting
