weather latter part Employed
Stowing Down Oil at 10 am Saw
a Sail to the Southward Lat 29.15

Thursday

June 25th

first part moderate breezes and
pleasant weather latter part
light air and pleasant at 9 am
Saw Spinn Whales and lowered
to End the Day Lat 28.50 S

Friday

June 26th

the Day beginning with pleasant
weather at 1 pm struck a large
Whale at 5 pm took the whale
to the ship and lay by him through
the night at 5 signs to catch and at
6 am saw more whales and lowered
without success to End the Day

Saturday

June 27th

at 3 pm Come on board and
Commence cutting and finished
the body and 8 pm put Mr Robison
Second mate in charge from refusing
his duty Lat 29.01 S Long 167.01

Sunday

June 28th

Through the Day Employed hauling
Mr Robison returns to his duty
Lat 29.25 S

first part moderate breezes and ple
asant weather at 1 pm finished hauling
latter part pleasant at 6 am
Saw a large Spinn Whale going
quartz to the windward. Did
not lower for him Lat 29.24
Long by Lane 167.55 Chron 167.15 E

Through the Day strong breezes
and pleasant weather Lat 27.10

Wednesday

July 1st

first part pleasant weather Employed
lower Caberney Oil at 7 am Saw
a Sail to the Southward latter part
Employed Stowing Down Oil Lat 27.07

Thursday

July 2nd

first part strong breezes and
pleasant No Whales Lat 28.50

Friday

July 3rd

Through the Day strong breezes from
S.W. ship heading to the westward
Saw fins of Whales and myself sick
latter part saw a sail to the
Southward Lat 29.00 S Long 167.26 E

Saturday

July 4th

first part moderate breezes and plea
sant weather at 5 pm struck the
Ship's beam of a man from
Capt Mayhew 36 months out
950 Spinn 100 Whale latter part
strong breezes the 26 in sight
Lat 29.33 S

Sunday

Through the Day strong gales from
South Long 167.50 S Lat 30.10

Through the Day strong breezes from
South all hand Employed repairing
the fore sail Lat 30.10 North
