 July 10th Through the Day Strong breezes from E Ship leaving at 10 AM pleasant Lat 28 46 Long 166 26 E

Sat Day July 11th Through the Day Strong breezes from ESE Lat 29 20 Long 166 43 E

Sunday July 12th Through the Day Strong breezes and pleasant weather at 6 AM we sail to the beach and under all sail Lat 30 55 N 166 50

Mon Day July 13th first part Strong breezes pleasant weather at 5 AM saw sperm whale going quick to windward did not lower for them Lat 30 37 N

Tues Day July 14th Through the Day Strong breezes and cloudy weather at 5 AM spoke the Barkentine in more of St Johns 9 months out 100 sperm 10 whale Lat 29 58 N

Wed Day July 15th Through the Day light airs pleasant weather 2 ships in sight Lat 29 01 N

Thurs Day July 16th Through the Day Strong breezes and pleasant weather Long 166 4 Lat 28 48

Fri Day July 17th Through the Day moderate breezes and pleasant weather Lat 29 50

Sat Day July 18th Through the Day light gales and pleasant weather at 9 AM saw sperm whales going quick to the S E did not lower Lat 30 22 N 168 45 E

 Sat Day July 19th first part fresh breezes and pleasant weather at 5 AM saw sperm whales and lowered struck and at 7 took the whale to the ship latter part fine weather Lat 30 33

Mon Day July 20th first part pleasant weather at 1 1/2 PM saw sperm whales lowered struck and at 7 took him to the ship and took in sail for the night at 5 AM commenced cutting at 8 finished and commenced boiling 168 30 E Lat 30 33 N

Tues Day July 21st Through the Day Strong breezes and pleasant weather employed boiling Lat 29 27 N Long 168 15 East

Wed Day July 22nd Through the Day Strong breezes and pleasant weather at 3 AM finished boiling Lat 29 22 N

Thurs Day July 23rd Through the Day Strong breezes and pleasant weather Lat 30 50 N

Fri Day July 24th Through the Day moderate breezes and pleasant weather and at 5 AM spoke ship given up Long 34 months out with 600 lbs Lat saw 3 sail Lat 31 02 168 12 E

Sat Day July 25th began with light breezes and pleasant weather Lat 31 37 N Long 168 55 E

Sun Day July 26th first part light breezes and pleasant weather at 1 PM saw sperm whales lowered struck and took him to ship boat in chase of the whales at 4 AM began to cut and at 9 finished and commenced boiling 3 ships in sight Lat 32 06 N
