After a considerable long time the cotton market you ship for ship's agent has come to hand and in regard to the quantity of goods your Bill is correct, but as to prices, you have charged me one cent a yard higher than the prices named in your "Market" given to me Mr. Brown this month saying that you would inform me if any alteration in prices took place I am under the impression when I order the duck that the prices would be the same

as you stated at that time. The prices you gave me B. is as follows viz \$2.2000 in yard falling one cent a yard for material less 5% to dealers. 6 1/2% or 5% less for cash I observe you have charged me 2100 a yard for \$2.20 less 12 1/2% for now any class in this market quite a difference to me whether your discount one cent a yard or 3 1/2% your answer is expected by return mail whether I am to have the duck at your former quotation or if you intend to charge me 21 cts per yard.
