Monday the 29th of November 1847
all of these 24 hours strong winds
and pleasant weather steering by the S. E. & S. E.
with the Bark in company Lat 24° 37'

Tuesday the 30th

all of these 24 hours strong winds and squally
weather steering by the Southward with the bark
in company So Ends

Wednesday the 1st of December 1847

all of these 24 hours strong winds and pleasant
weather at steering by the Southward with the bark
in company employed in fitting rigging So Ends

Thursday the 2nd

all of these 24 hours light winds and pleasant
weather at 4 AM made the Island of St.
Antonio one of the Cape de Verde the
Bark and 2 more sails in company So Ends

Friday the 3rd

all of these 24 hours light winds and pleasant
weather steering by the Southward with the
Bark in company and the Island in sight
So Ends

Saturday the 4th

all of these 24 hours strong winds and squally
weather at 2 PM made the Island of Isabella
at 4 AM lowered away the S. Bark and the
Bark went on shore and got some fruit

Sunday the 5th

all of these 24 hours lying off and on and
in the course of the day got 2 Eggs and some
Oranges and Chickens the Bark and the
Elizabeth of N. Y. the Family of Sanitucked
in company

Ship Pacific Orient

Monday December the 6th 1847

all of these 24 hours strong winds at 12 PM the
Bark returned on board with 15 men from the
Capt. Stued at 11 PM squared off in
company with the Bark

Tuesday the 7th

all of these 24 hours strong breezes and squally
weather steering of with the Bark in company
So Ends

Wednesday the 8th

all of these 24 hours strong winds and
squally weather at 11 AM the Bark set
policies for Whales at 10 PM with us
chasing with the Ship



Thursday the 9th

all of these 24 hours strong winds and
squally weather at 12 PM a boat lowered the
No. 1 S. Bark and chased at 1 PM the S. B.
came down and chased until 3 PM and then
returned to the Ship at 4 PM was
a pod of Whales came up close to the Ship
we lowered the S. and W. Barks but got none
So Ends

Friday the 10th

Commences with strong winds and squally
weather later part light winds and pleasant
weather So Ends

Saturday the 11th

all of these 24 hours light winds and
pleasant weather later part employed
unloading but for water all day a number
of sails in sight

Sunday the 12th

all of these 24 hours light winds and
pleasant weather with 3 sails in sight
