4 sails in sight Employed in picking over
potatoes and other jobs So Ends

Tuesday the 14th
all of these 24 hours light wind and
squally weather Employed in taking the
Anchors and other heavy goods So Ends

Wednesday the 15th
all of these 24 hours strong winds blowing
by the S.W. and day commenced
stripping the yards and getting the rigging
So Ends

Thursday the 16th
all of these 24 hours fine breeze and pleasant
weather Employed in getting the rigging on
the fore mast yard So Ends

Friday the 17th
all of these 24 hours strong winds
blowing by the S.W. Lat 30 03

Saturday the 18th
all of these 24 hours strong winds and
pleasant weather Sailed part Employed
in breaking out between decks So Ends

Sunday the 19th
all of these 24 hours strong winds
blowing by the S.W. Lat 31 48

Monday the 20th
all of these 24 hours strong winds blowing
by the S.W. Employed in getting the rigging
Saw 1 sail steering for the Cape Verde
So Ends

Ship - Pacific - 1847

Tuesday the 21st of December 1847
all of these 24 hours fine breeze
and pleasant weather steering S.W. by S
Employed in getting the rigging Lat 31 47

Wednesday the 22nd
all of these 24 hours fine breeze and pleasant
weather Employed in getting the rigging saw
2 sails steering to the southward So Ends

Thursday the 23rd
all of these 24 hours fine breeze and
pleasant weather steering S.W. by S Employed
in getting the rigging So Ends

Friday the 24th
all of these 24 hours fine breeze and
pleasant weather all hands Employed
in getting the rigging at 10 am carried away
on the fore topmast shrouds So Ends

Saturday the 25th
all of these 24 hours fine breeze
and pleasant weather Employed in
breaking out for masts and coopers
3 pieces of wood this day passed
the age of the Herald of 25 years
Lat 31 40 long 30 59

Sunday the 26th
pleasant weather steering S.W. by S
So Ends

all of these 24 hours fine breeze and
pleasant weather Employed in getting up
the rigging and other jobs So Ends

Tuesday the 28th
all of these 24 hours fine breeze and
pleasant weather Employed in getting up the rigging
and in part masts in the main rigging
