steering W. & W. Lat 8:06 S. 85:50

Saturday the 18th

first part light winds and pleasant
weather Employed in fitting gear
at 4th a.m. had a smart shower of
rain latter part strong winds
steering W. & W. Employed fitting
Boats and repairing a m. old
day sail Lat 6:33 Long 88:30

Sunday the 19th

and pleasant at 5th called all hands
washed off saw nothing but fin Backs
