

Ship Abigail Running

Sunday April the 2^d 1848
first part light winds and pleasant
Employed in blacking the Iron work aloft
at 6 P.M. lost one of the S.B.
Crabs overboard latter part the same
Saw nothing but porpoises

Monday the 3^d
first part fine weather Employed
in blacking the Iron work
latter part the same blacking Iron
work and making a new Crane
Steering Westward

Tuesday the 4th
Commodore with pleasant weather
Employed in blacking the topsail sheets
and other Iron work at 5 P.M. raised
a breeze and proved to be S.W. hails
a going to the windward as the sun
was a going to windward into the
horizon we lowered the S & W Dye
but got nothing we returned to the
Ship and took in sail and steered
N by E Saw nothing more but S.B. Crabs
Lat 10.36 Long 113.54

Wednesday the 5th
all of the day light winds and
pleasant weather Saw nothing of note

Thursday the 6th
all of the day light winds and
fine weather Employed in blacking
but for molasses latter part
sent down the main sail and commenced
repairing in the day saw nothing
but S.B. Crabs steering to the Westward
Lat 11.00 Long 113.16

Down the Line to the Westward

Friday the 7th of April 1848
first part fine breeze Steering W by W
Employed in repairing the main sail
latter part the same steering to S.W.
Lat 11.17 Long 120.16

Saturday the 8th
first part fine wind at 3 P.M. saw
Whales latter part the same
at 1 saw four or five saw some
more Employed Lifting up the head
sails Lat 11.08 Long 121.44

Sunday the 9th
first part fine weather steering to the
Westward at 3 P.M. saw a school of
Black fish the Capt. lowered his boat
but got none latter part the same
Lat 11.08 Long 123.18

Monday the 10th
first part light winds and fine
weather latter part Employed in
blackening but for water saw nothing
but porpoises Lat 10.30

Tuesday the 11th
first part fine weather Employed
in throwing up the hold and put
down 4 bales of oil in the fore hold
latter part the same Lat 10.56

Wednesday the 12th
first part fine weather Employed
in various jobs about deck
latter part the same Employed in
blackening but between decks and
making a potstow room saw nothing
but porpoises Lat 10.31
Steering N.W. by W
