Thursday April 13th 1848

first part strong winds steering
N to by W employed in making a
Potatoes pinn and showing off between
Decks latter part light winds
and pleasant employed in cleaning
windlapp rigors Lat 13° 16' Long 129° 00'

Friday the 14th

first part light winds and pleasant
weather latter part light winds and
cloudy steering N to by W employed in
stirring up the mizen topmast backstays

Saturday the 15th

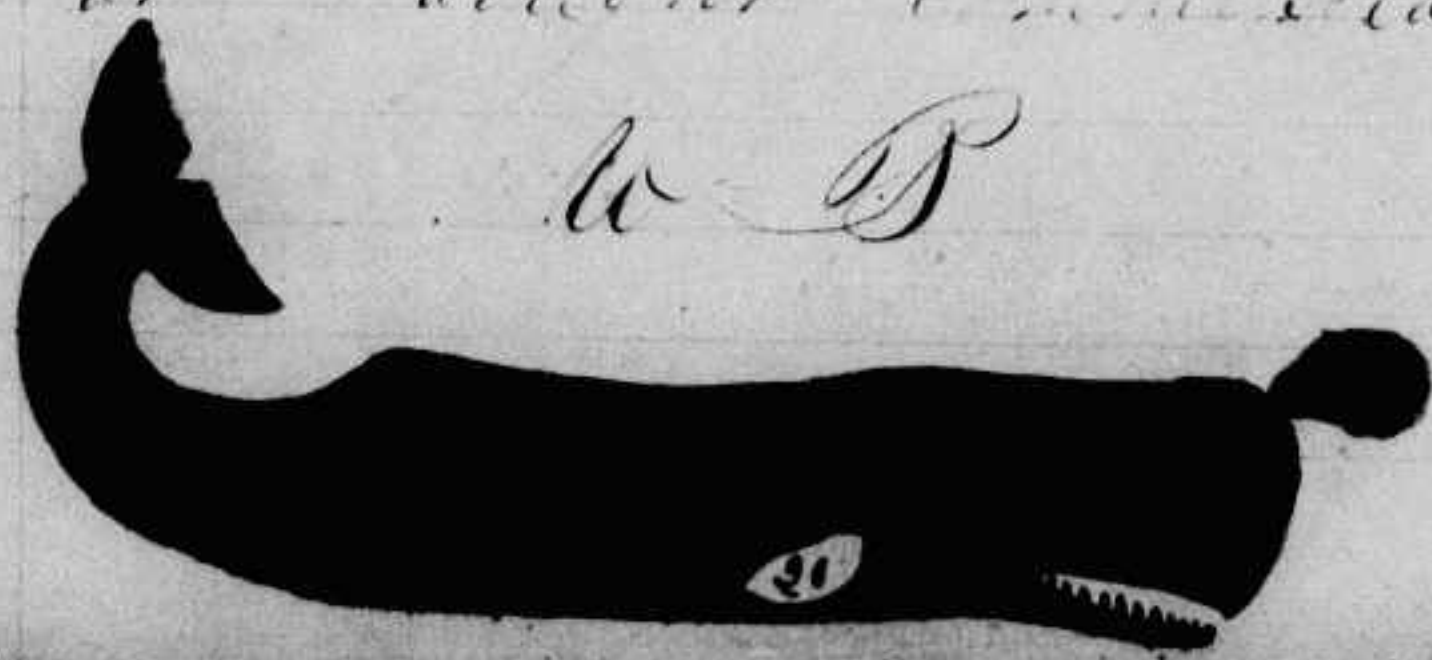
all of these 24 hours light wind
from the Eastward and rainy
steering N by W

Sunday the 16th

all of these fine rainy weather at 8 a.m.
raised whaler 8 p.m. lowered the
S L and W 10 a.m. at 10 p.m. to B
struck the whaler, sloped to the S
struck her again and struck another
and drove again at 1 p.m. to S
Lat 6° 00'

Monday the 17th

commenced with rainy weather at 1
p.m. the boats returned to the ship
the W boat got on shore a on side
then we got under and commenced
cudding at 5 p.m. and got supper
and at 8 p.m. washed and cut the
blubber up and pitch it down below
at present commenced rain



The Sandwich Islands

Tuesday the 18th of April 1848

commenced with cloudy weather employed
Boiling at 7 it rained so we cooled
down at 8 started the work again
at 9 cooled down again and let them
than until daylight at 1 a.m.
cooled again on account of rain
at 8 started again at 11 p.m. finished
at 12 o'clock

Wednesday the 19th

all of these 24 hours strong winds
and rainy weather steering to the
Northward

Thursday the 20th

commenced with rainy weather the wind
from the Southward at 6 p.m. the wind
hauling to the Westward and blowing
on hard so that we furlled the
main sail and close reefed the top
sails at 1 a.m. it did away entirely
at 6 a.m. light breeze sprang up
from the Eastward Lat 10° 00' 134

Friday the 21st

all of these fine weather with
light winds from the Eastward
employed in making a Potatoes
pinn and Deck Lat 11° 00'

Saturday the 22nd

first part light winds and
latter part strong winds from the S
saw nothing but porpoises

Sunday the 23rd

all of these 24 hours strong winds steering
to by S Lat 13° 43' Long 141° 03'
