Monday Augst the 21st 1848
all of the 24 hours fine
weather. Latter Employed Coopersing
Bread at 9 a.m. raised a Sail
Saw some fin Backs 33.26 165.00

Tuesday the 22nd
fine weather first part Employed
in Breacking down wood & coopersing
Bread at 6 P.M. spoke the Narragansett
she had fallen 90 fath since we saw
her. Latter part Breacking out the
after hold & coopersing Bread & meat
33.27 164.34

Wednesday the 23rd
all of the 24 hours light winds
from the Eastward steering by the S.E.
Saw nothing but Porpoys and the Stars

Thursday the 24th
Strong winds from the E steering by to
the S.E. at 6 P.M. spoke & gammed
with the Narragansett Saw porpoises

Friday the 25th
Strong winds steering by to the
S.E. in company with the S

Saturday the 26th
all of the 24 hours strong winds
from the Eastward at 9 P.M.
spoke & parted company with the
Narragansett

Sunday the 27th
strong winds and squally weather
33.10

On Japan

Monday Aug the 28th 1848
Strong winds and rain steering
by the S.E. 30.12

Tuesday the 29th
Strong winds and rain from
the Southward steering E by S
at 6 a.m. saw a ship
and spoke her she proved
to be the Narragansett

Wednesday the 30th
Strong winds from the S.W.
steering to the Eastward
at 2 P.M. the ship went
on board the S at 6
returned

Thursday the 31st
Strong winds from the S.W.
steering E by S in company
with the Narragansett
30.14

Friday the 1st of Sept^r 1848
Strong winds from the S.W.
steering E the middle part
we had a heavy tempest the
hauled away round the compass
at 12 mid split the main top sail
latter part it blew heavy
more too under a close reef main
top sail

Saturday the 2nd
commenced with strong gales &
squally weather at 10 a.m.
spoke and gammed with the S
the came on board of us and took
4 f. of iron with him and we went
down and got 4 more for end spoke gam
31.01 174.21
