

Ship Abigail Cruising on

Tuesday the 19th of June 1849
first part Strong winds from the
the Southward steering by to the
N E at 12 P.M. saw gunpowder another
day of doubtful success it past
and the prospect grows darker with
every succeeding one at 6 A.M. sent
down the main sail to Repair after
Breakfast commenced on it

Wednesday the 20th
Strong & Breezes from the Southward
first part steering N E to at 3 o'clock
in sail and lifted too up the back
at 4 A.M. made sail and put
her off N E to Employed sail mending
saw gunpowder

Thursday the 21st
Strong winds from the Southward
steering to the Northward
Employed in Repairing sails

Friday the 22nd
Strong wind and rain at 3 P.M.
sent down the main top sail
to Repair at

Saturday the 23rd
Strong wind from the North
at 1 P.M. sent the main
top sail again Lat 32° 11' 30"

Sunday the 24th
fine weather the wind from
the Southward saying to get to
the Southward Lat 32° 05'

The Japan Ground

Monday June the 25th 1849
Strong winds from the Southward
Lat 31° 45' 172° 22'

Tuesday the 26th
Strong winds from the Southward
under close Reefed top sails
later part broke out 1 East
of water it being so Rugged
that it was not safe to go
into the lower hold

Wednesday the 27th
all of these 24 hours
blowing a gale of wind at
with rain at 9 A.M. it
blew very heavy so that we took
in the fore sail at 6 A.M.
fore sail and fore & main top sails
close Reefed at 8 P.M. put
out of the main top sail

Thursday the 28th
first part Strong winds from
the Southward steering by under
close Reefed top sails at 6
P.M. took in the fore and main
top sails at 6 P.M. let them
again all Rain

Friday the 29th
all of these 24 hours Strong
gale from the Southward with
a good deal of Rain being too
under a close Reefed main
top sail with heavy Rain
